WHEREAS,

was recognized as a 2026 AAPI Honoree at the Asian American Pacific Islander Heritage Month kick-off event at City Hall on Friday, May, 1; and

WHEREAS, *Asian American and Pacific Islander honorees enrich the community through commitment to their cultural heritage while finding ways to connect, belong, and grow alongside it shaping its future success and enhancing its cultural landscape; and*

WHEREAS, *Nuducha Yang is the Court Business Manager at the Milwaukee Municipal Court, as a financial professional she leads financial operations and manages an accounting team, and as a community leader she serves as the AAPI ERG Executive Sponsor, championing inclusion of marginalized groups, including LGBTQ+ and transgender communities, and breaking language barriers; and*
