**WHEREAS,**

***BAY VIEW TERRACE***

*celebrated its 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary during a special event on October 5, 2014 at the South Shore Yacht Club, 2300 E. Nock St.; and*

***WHEREAS,** In 1964, Bay View Terrace became the first condominium building in the state of Wisconsin; and*

***WHEREAS,** Bay View Terrace was created using a unique, continuous poured concrete construction method and is notably 148 units, making the building the most populated block in the Bay View area; and*

***WHEREAS,** The Bay View Terrace is a visible landmark along Milwaukee's south shore lakefront and is distinguished for its view in the evening as the sunset reflects off the metal bands on the side of the building, creating a pink hue; and*

***WHEREAS,** Bay View's lakefront high-rise, Bay View Terrace is renowned for its rich culture and city lifestyle; now, therefore, be it*

***RESOLVED,** That the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee herewith congratulates Bay View Terrace on the occasion of its 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary, and wishes for it continued vibrancy and success; and, be it*
