There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

Update: The video showing the incident on November 29, 2025 with Harold García From Illinois and other individuals inside and outside Fiesta Carambola was released and Noticias Wisconsin posted it on their Facebook page for public viewing and to be shared.

The García incident video released by Fiesta Carambola to Noticias Wisconsin on social media for public viewing is also being shared by Hispanic News Network U.S.A. (HNNUSA) who broke the story on Sunday, and the video was posted as a courtesy from Noticias Wisconsin. Attempts by HNNUSA to contact Walter Garron from Noticias Wisconsin were unsuccessful.

The video shows García inside Fiesta Carambola talking with other individuals (no sound), then several security guards asked García to leave and escorted García out of Fiesta Carambola. Then multiple individuals go outside, exchanged some words and then one of them strikes García and several more jumped on García while the security guards from Fiesta Carambola stayed inside and watch García get beaten by the unidentified individuals without intervening. It is not clear in the video, if any Fiesta Carambola employees wearing the Fiesta Carambola business logo were involved as well, as García had claimed.

The video now becomes public evidence that García was criminally assaulted outside Fiesta Carambola by unidentified individuals.

Also, that the private security contracted by Fiesta Carambola and Fiesta Carambola management at the time failed to prevent the individuals that assaulted García go outside. Both the private security and Fiesta Carambola employees failed to call police as well.

I looked up, if any type of business permit, beer or alcohol license were approved for Fiesta Carambola to operated and I found none available, unless I missed a current City site with information.

The property at 1910 W. Becker St. shows Valdemar Escobar as the owner, who operates his business brands of Fiesta Garibaldi, Fiesta Cafe and Chicken Palace and ect. in the Southside of Milwaukee.

I wanted to find out who operates the 1910 W. Becher St. location and if it's legally operating under the City of Milwaukee licensing permits.

Any information available about tge location 1910 W. Becher St. is appreciated.

Lastly, can a business or tavern that are approved for a Class B Tavern license, also sell shots of liquor and mixed alcohol drinks at the tavern or restaurant?

I'm including an article link that was published on Sunday regarding an incident that happened at Fiesta Carambola where a man from Illinois was allegedly assaulted and cellphone stolen on early Sunday, November 30, 2025.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 11/06/20 the applicant was cited in the City of Milwaukee at 1937 W. Forest Home Avenue for Food Dealers License Required and Mask Required Indoors

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2. On 06/29/25 at 1:37a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Shot Spotter at 1909 W. Forest Home. Investigation revealed this was a Shooting that occurred at 1937 W. Forest Home Ave. The victim stated they were slapped by a subject inside the bar. The subject and their party were escorted out by security. As the victim was leaving they observed a group of subjects assaulting their friend. When the victim attempted to intervene, they too were assaulted and heard gunshots, realizing they were struck in the back of the head. A CAD search revealed the business did not call police regarding the fight, shots fired or shooting.

3. On 07/05/25 at 5:12p.m., Milwaukee Police on patrol observed a taco stand in front of the business burst into flames. The employee stated they heard a hissing sound and observed a cloud of fire erupt. The business was cooperative.
4. On 09/05/25 at 12:34a.m., Milwaukee Police took a walk-in stabbing that occurred on 09/04/25 at 11:30p.m. The victim stated they were at 1937 W, Forest Home Ave., and were dancing with an unknown subject, when two subjects began to argue with them. The victims stated when they exited the premise, they were attacked and stabbed. One victim sustained multiple lacerations to their face, abdomen and arm. The officer conducted follow up, however, found the business closed and were unable to contact the Agent via the phone. The officer further noted blood splatter outside the business and in the middle of the street.
5. On 09/20/25 at 10:00p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Battery. The caller stated they were in the bar and got into a verbal altercation, that later turned physical with another group in the bathroom. Security kicked both groups out, however, a short time later a physical fight took place outside between the groups, causing security to again break up the fight. A single gunshot was heard, however, undetermined who fired the shot.
6. On 02/10/26 at 3:00p.m., a Milwaukee Police Officer preparing for a meeting with the Agent, checked calls for service at the location and noted three Shot Spotters on the following dates/times, however officers were unable to locate any casings or property struck:
 - 10/13/25 9:05p.m. 1 round at the location
 - 11/22/25 2:12a.m. 2 rounds in the street on Becher
 - 11/26/25 4:08a.m. 5 rounds in the parking lot

This report is written by PO Matthew DIENER, assigned to District 2, day shift, squad 2166. On Sunday, June 29th, 2025 at about 1:37am squads were dispatched to a Shotspotter complaint at 1909 W Forest Home Av. Upon arrival officer observed a Hispanic male with a gun shot wound to the back of his head. Responding detectives arrived on scene and interviewed witnesses and the victim about the events that occurred. Detectives interviewed the victim, BERNAL-ALVARADO, who stated he went to the bar a little after 8:00 PM, and he met with his friend, Jesus GALLOSO-ROSARIO (h/m 11/10/83). BERNAL-ALVARADO stated they were at the bar without any issues for a few hours. BERNAL-ALVARADO stated that while at the bar, at approximately 12:00 AM on Sunday, June 29, 2025, he talked to a female at the bar. BERNAL-ALVARADO stated he believed the female was GALLOSO-ROSARIO's neighbor. BERNAL-ALVARADO stated he said "Hi" to the female, but she was acting aggressively. BERNAL-ALVARADO stated she yelled at him, and he believed it was because she had an issue with somebody else while at the bar. BERNAL-ALVARADO stated the female slapped him.

BERNAL-ALVARADO stated the female was there with four other males, but he wasn't sure on the exact number of people. BERNAL-ALVARADO stated the female and her male friends were escorted out of the bar by security. BERNAL-ALVARADO stated he stayed in the bar for approximately five minutes with GALLOSO-ROSARIO, and he told GALLOSO-ROSARIO that the female hit him. BERNAL-ALVARADO stated GALLOSO-ROSARIO wanted to go talk to the female about her hitting him.

BERNAL-ALVARADO stated GALLOSO-ROSARIO walked out of the bar through the front door, and shortly after, BERNAL-ALVARADO followed him. BERNAL-ALVARADO stated he didn't see how it started, but when he got outside, he saw the group of males attacking GALLOSO-ROSARIO. BERNAL-ALVARADO stated GALLOSO-ROSARIO was laying on the ground while being physically assaulted, and BERNAL-ALVARADO tried to break up the altercation. BERNAL-ALVARADO stated he tried to pull one of the males away from attacking GALLOSO-ROSARIO, but BERNAL-ALVARADO got pushed to the ground and was also hit multiple times. BERNAL-ALVARADO stated that while he was on the ground, he heard five gunshots fired, and he felt one of the gunshots hit him on the back of the head. BERNAL-ALVARADO stated that after the gunshots were fired, all of the attackers fled the area in an unknown direction.

BERNAL-ALVARADO stated he did not see the person who shot him, and he didn't see any of them holding a gun. BERNAL-ALVARADO stated he wasn't sure if the female he was initially talking to in the bar was one of the people in the group of attackers.

On 07/05/2025 at approximately 5:12PM, I was conducting general patrol and stopped at a red light at the intersection of W Forest Home AV and W Becher ST facing northbound. While stopped I observed a taco stand displayed in front of 1937 W Forest Home AV (Chicken Palace) burst into flames. I observed multiple subjects run away from the taco stand. One of those subjects was later identified as Daniel CRUZ-CRISPIN (W/M, 05/17/1992). I immediately requested MFD and began blocking traffic. Upon MFD arriving they extinguished the flames. I located CRUZ-CRISPIN and conducted a witness interview.

CRUZ-CRISPIN stated he was standing at the grill when he heard hissing sound and observed a cloud of fire erupt from within the grill. CRUZ-CRISPIN stated he was the manager, and the owner (whom was not on scene) is Valdemar ESCOBAR (W/M, 12/09/1967).

The business was *cooperative with the* investigation. I did not observe any security officers on scene.

I did not review any video surveillance footage as I observed the incident occur but observed cameras on scene.

While on scene, I observed the licenses posted and they were up to date. During my investigation, I did not observe any violations in the licensed premise.

On Friday September 5th, 2025, assigned to Squad 2474 (Myself and PO Hector MUNOZ) responded to assist with a "stabbing" at the location of 1910 W Becher ST, which is in the City and County of Milwaukee.

Primary Officer Maritza REYES received a walk in complaint at the District Two Station for a "stabbing" that occurred September 4th, 2025, at 11:30 PM at the location of 1910 W Becher ST (Fiesta Carambola Bar). The two victims stated that the incident had initially began in the bar. The two victims stated they were dancing with an unknown female subject inside of the location. The two victims stated that a group of male subjects who were with the unknown female subject began to verbally argue with them. The two victims stated they went outside of the location and were physically attacked and stabbed by the group of male subjects. One victim suffered substantial lacerations to his face, abdomen and right arm.

Upon arrival at approximately 1:34 am I observed the business to be closed with all lights off, doors locked and no occupants inside of the location. I observed multiple cameras on the outside of the location. I attempted to contact the Business Agent Valdemar ESCOBAR (H/M 12/09/1967) by phone but received no answer. I did observe blood splatter outside of the location located on in the middle of the street in front of the location.

All licensing of the location is currently valid.

I could not observe any violations at the time due to location being closed upon our arrival.

Upon *our arrival* we spoke to the caller who was identified as Gilberto JUAREZ (W/M 08/31/1982) was in the bar with his co-workers and the victim who was verbally identified as Jose PEREZ-JUAREZ (W/M 04/21/1997.) Gilberto was translating due to Jose being Spanish speaking only and did not wish to provide any further info due to fear of immigration.

Gilberto stated they were in the bar for approximately 5 minutes, when he and an individual (UNKNOWN Male, Black Shoes, Tan pants, grey shirt, and black in color green bay packer's hat) got into a verbal altercation. The altercation turned physical inside the bathroom. A customer informed the manager and security, who went into the restroom and kicked out both groups.

Once both parties were outside, the argument continued, and the victim and his party were told to wait inside while the unknown party leaves.

According to the manager, once the unknown party left, the victim party were outside the doors sitting on a nearby picnic table, and approximately 15-20 minutes pass, and the unknown party returns and they engaged in a physical altercation outside again and security breaks up the fight and the unknown party left in an unknown blue sedan.

Gilberto stated prior to them leaving they heard a single gunshot, however there were no other witnesses to this account.

The manager allowed me to view video, but the outside camera was blurry and could not view a potential fight, and the interior camera shows the parties talking and then go into the bathroom, and later security is seen going in the bathroom escorting out the parties involved. Also, interior front door camera captures the individuals outside arguing and then victims party entering.

5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
