| <p>Legislation</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - SB323 Victim Accompaniment Signed - Supported <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o AB673, Tabled: Creating a program to protect the confidentiality of addresses for victims of domestic abuse, sexual assault, or stalking; providing an exemption from emergency rule procedures; and requiring the exercise of rule-making authority (SB488 enacted) o AB767, Enacted: This bill allows a court that enjoins a person (respondent) from certain acts of harassment, domestic abuse, or other abuse to order a wireless telephone service provider (provider) to transfer, from the respondent to the person who requested the injunction (petitioner), all rights to, and responsibility for, the use of telephone numbers used by the petitioner or by his or her minor children. (SB626 held) o AB737, Tabled: Relating to: the crime of child sex trafficking, the inclusion of child sex trafficking in the definition of child abuse, the investigation of a child abuse report in which a person who is not a caregiver of the child is suspected of permitting, allowing, or encouraging the child to engage in prostitution or of child sex trafficking for purposes of a commercial sex act, and providing a penalty.
