
REASON FOR REQUEST:

Mark Whaley, a City of Milwaukee DPW employee, was in the scope of his employment and operating a City of Milwaukee parking enforcement vehicle that was traveling southbound on West Fond Du Lac Avenue. As the City vehicle approached the intersection with West Ridge Court, the uninsured motorist, who was also traveling southbound on West Fond Du Lac Avenue at a high rate of speed, failed to yield at the right away and rear ended the City vehicle, causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Mr. Whaley sustained injuries to his neck and left shoulder. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$31,211.43.
