Dear Ms. Moreno:

We have received your claim in the amount of \$679.00, relating to damage to your fence, hedges and bush at 5505 West Chambers Street on the weekend of July 25, 2020 when a branch from a City tree fell onto them.

The Forestry Section records indicate that late in the evening of July 7, 2020 they received an after-hours emergency request regarding a broken branch down on a private fence and into a private yard at 5505 West Chambers Street. They responded in the early morning hours of July 8, 2020 and found that a branch from a Honey Locust street tree had broken and bent the top rail of the fence and possibly the post. They removed the branch. The branch was alive with decay which was not visible from the outside.

The Section notes that Milwaukee experienced a thunderstorm event with peak wind speeds of 31 miles per hour and 1.25 inches of rain on July 7, 2020. They also reviewed their records for the last 6 years at this location for tree-related issues and found, prior to this request, a request on November 3, 2016 for pruning all trees adjacent to this corner lot. Subsequently, it was handled and no issues were found. The trees in this area are on a 10 year pruning schedule and were last pruned in February 2020.
