The Board may receive a motion to convene in closed session in City Hall, room 301-B, 200 East Wells Street, to consider the above promotions and appointment resolutions, residency extension request, demotions, or disciplines, pursuant to Section 19.85(1)(b), Wis. Stat. for the purpose of considering dismissal, demotion, licensing or discipline of any public employee or person licensed by the Commission or the investigation of charged against such person, pursuant to Section 19.85(1)(c), Wis. Stat. for the purpose of considering employment, promotion, compensation, or performance evaluation data of any public employee over which the Commission has jurisdiction or exercises responsibility, and pursuant to Section 19.85(1)(f), Wis. Stat., for the purpose of considering financial, medical, social or personal histories or disciplinary data of specific personnel problems or the investigation of charges against specific persons which, if discussed in public, would be likely to have a substantial adverse effect upon the reputation of any person referred to in such histories or data, or involved in such problems or investigations. The Board may then reconvene in open session concerning any such item following the closed session.
