The Fire & Police Commission Board will meet with representatives from the Milwaukee Police Department, Collaborative Community Committee, Office of Violence Prevention, and the Milwaukee LGBT Community Center (hereby referred to as panelists) to discuss the following items:

Motion to Ajourn

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In the event that there is a quorum of members of the Board of the Fire and Police Commission in attendance at this meeting, this meeting may also simultaneously constitute a meeting of the Fire and Police Commission or any of the following committees: Testing and Recruiting, Policies and Standards, Research, Complaints and/or Discipline. Whether a simultaneous meeting is occurring depends on whether the presence of one or more of the Fire and Police Commission members results in a quorum or negative quorum of the Fire and Police Commission or any of the above committees, and, if there is a quorum of another committee, whether any agenda items listed above involve matters within that committee's realm of authority. In the event that a simultaneous meeting is occurring, no action other than information gathering will be taken at either meeting.
