This resolution expresses support for Wisconsin 2011 Senate Bill 165. Under this bill, a resident of Milwaukee County may obtain a free birth certificate for one year following the effective date of the bill if the resident needs the birth certificate to obtain a driver's license or identification card for voting. Body

Whereas, Under current state law, beginning with the 2012 spring primary election, an elector must present proof of identification that includes a photograph of the individual to vote in an election; and

Whereas, One of the requirements for obtaining a Wisconsin identification card or driver's license is providing proof of name and date of birth by presenting a certified U.S. birth certificate, valid passport or certificate of naturalization; and

Whereas, Under s. 69.22, Wis. Stats., there is a fee of \$20 for a certified birth certificate; and

Whereas, The required fee for obtaining a certified birth certificate may place an undue financial

burden on eligible voters, particularly elderly, minority and rural voters; and

Whereas, Under Wisconsin 2011 Senate Bill 165, a resident of Milwaukee County may obtain a free birth certificate for one year following the effective date of the bill if the resident needs the birth certificate to obtain a driver's license or identification card for voting; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that the Department of Administration-Intergovernmental Relations Division is directed to lobby for passage of Wisconsin 2011Senate Bill 165, an act relating to birth certificates for Milwaukee County residents.

2011 SENATE BILL 165

August 11, 2011 – Introduced by Senator S. Coggs, cosponsored by Representatives Young, E. Coggs, Kessler and Berceau. Referred to Committee on Judiciary, Utilities, Commerce, and Government Operations.

AN ACT relating to: birth certificates for Milwaukee County residents.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, beginning with the 2012 spring primary election, an individual must present proof of identification that includes a photograph of the individual to vote in an election. Under current law, a driver's license or a state identification card issued by the Department of Transportation are permissible forms of identification for voting.

Under this bill, a resident of Milwaukee County may obtain a free birth certificate for one year following the effective date of the bill if the resident needs the birth certificate in order to obtain a driver's license or identification card for the purpose of voting.

For further information see the *state and local* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Nonstatutory provisions.

(1) Birth certificates for resident of Milwaukee County. Ending one year after the effective date of this subsection [LRB inserts date], and notwithstanding section 69.22 (1) of the statutes, the state registrar and any local registrar acting

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under subchapter I of chapter 69 of the statutes may not collect the fees described in section 69.22 (1) (c) of the statutes if the requester states, in writing, that the requester is an elector and a resident of Milwaukee County and that the birth certificate is being obtained for the purpose of obtaining an operator's license issued under chapter 343 of the statutes or an identification card issued under section 343.50 of the statutes for purposes of voting.

To whom it may concern:

On May 12th, 2011 my car was towed due to unpaid parking citations by the City of Milwaukee. Inside the car were two 8GB Ipod Touches, one belonging to myself, and one to my girlfriend, Stephanie La Haye. Both items were stowed in an interior compartment just under the CD deck. When we retrieved the car, both items were missing.

After receiving the letter from the City of Milwaukee informing us that our claim was denied, I immediately decided appeal the decision. Much of the City's reasoning is based upon totally, undoubted trust of City Employees. This is not to say that have doubt in the City of Milwaukee's Civil Servants, but one solid fact that this case is built upon, and the entire reason for denying our claim, was left out.

The letter I received states, "The vehicle was locked at the time of the tow. The forms completed at the time of the tow, arrival, and release at the tow lot, do not indicate that these items were visible. The items inside a vehicle towed to the lot are not inventoried. Since there is no evidence to supports your belief that the items were taken from the vehicle during the tow and storage process, the City cannot accept liability." While many of these points are valid, one major problem stands; the car was unlocked when returned back to me. If the doors were locked when my car was, and unlocked when it was returned, that they must have been opened by someone other than myself.

I have great respect for the City of Milwaukee employees, but was truly disappointed in this verdict. I feel that the investigation lacked enthusiasm and the City's decision to deny my claim was hasty and rash. Both Stephanie and I are college seniors, working full time to pay for our education. While these items may seem simple and easily replaced, it's the principle of the matter: someone who is employed by the city, in which we work, live, and pay taxes, stole our belongings. Please reconsider your decision to deny our claim and reopen this case for further investigation. Thank you for your time.

We return the enclosed document which has been filed with the City Clerk, and ask that it be introduced and referred to the Committee on Judiciary & Legislation with the following recommendation.

Claimant, Justine Stevens, 3845 Oakridge Court, Greenfield, WI 53220, alleges through Trans Pac Solutions, by its representative Diane Milligan, P.O. Box 36220, Louisville, KY 40233-6220 that on March 12, 2011 she sustained damages when a City water main broke and caused water to back up into her property. They claim damages in the amount of \$5,625.58.

Our investigation reveals that the Milwaukee Water Works (MWW) records indicate that on March 11, 2011 at 6:42 p.m. they received a call from the Greenfield Police Department regarding a leak in the street at South Oakbrook Drive and South Oakridge Court. The MWW dispatched a field investigator who confirmed a break in an 8-inch water main at 3815 South Oakbrook Drive, at the intersection of South Oakbrook Drive and South Oakridge Court, and shut off the water. They contacted Digger's Hotline for an emergency locate to mark the underground facilities in the area and initiated a call-out list for a distribution crew. The crew responded to the site and made the necessary repairs. The main was placed back in service at 5:30 a.m. on March 12, 2011. Subsequently, they back-filled and blacktopped the excavation with a temporary asphalt patch. They did not receive any calls, reports or complaints regarding this area, or their repair activity, until this claim was filed.

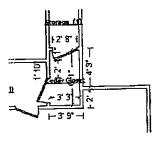

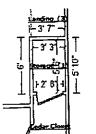

Re: Sewer Back Up Monday 4/11/11 -

i, Sandra Wagner, arrived home from work approximately 4:00 pm on Monday April 11, 2011. At around 4:30 pm i was heading into the basement area to get something out of the freezer. Halfway down the basement stairs i noticed what looked like a sheet of glass on the basement floor. As i reached the bottom of the stairs, I noticed that it was about 3-4 inches of standing water. The water covered the entire basement floor. I ran back up the stairs to get the phone. I called my husband at 4:39 as he was still at work. He suggested that I go down to check the sump pump. The water covered my shoe and was approximately 3-4 inches deep. I confirmed that the sump pump was working properly. He asked me to look in the laundry area - where I noticed that water was bubbling at the drain. He then asked me to call Feltner's Sewer & Drain Service and ask them to come out right away. I hung up the phone and went upstairs to get a phone book. Called Feltner's at around 4:45pm and they said they were sending a crew right away. My husband called back to say that he called the City of Milwaukee, because he noticed some work going on in our neighborhood and wanted to check to see if there were any issues. (4:52pm) the person on the other end of the line said, "How can you have water coming in your basement it isn't raining." "We'll send out a crew." My husband arrived home at around 5:30pm and we immediately started two submersible pumps to start taking the sewer water out of the basement and keep it from getting any deeper. These two pumps were just barely able to keep up with the amount of water coming up from the sewer. However, our quick thinking kept the water from destroying any major appliances. (Freezer, refrigerator, washer, dryer, water heater, furnace...etc)

When the crew from Feltner's arrived, at the house they went down into the basement and checked out ail our drains and to see where the water was coming from. They then went outside and proceeded to check out the manhole cover in front of the house, they stated that the main sewer was clogged and they were sure that the back up was not our issue. My husband arrived home as the crew from Feltner's was checking the manhole. Feltner's crew noticed a City of Milwaukee truck at the far North end of 3rd Street and walked down to talk to them. Feltner's returned and stated that it was a City of Milwaukee Sewer issue, but they could return on Wednesday 4/12/11, after the sewer was opened to clean out the lateral to the street. Stating that many times when the sewers are cleared with high powered flush that debris get into the lateral. We agreed to have this done and they did return to do the suggested work.

After the crew from Feltner's left, my husband also went down to talk to the City of Milwaukee crew on 3rd Street. They were looking at a series of maps/diagrams. My husband asked if they knew what the issue was and approximately how long before the sewer was re-opened. Joselyn Mc Kinnley, Sewer Supervisor stated that they were trying to find out where the main was clogged and the diagrams didn't seem to be current and were unsure how long it would be. They did however have a sewer jet crew in route. My husband returned and we continued to pump water, coming up from the sewer, out of the basement. A man working with Joselyn McKinnley - also entered our house to look at the basement and see where the water was coming from. He also stated that it was a City of Milwaukee sewer issue and what a horrible situation this was. He provided the information for filing a claim with the City of Milwaukee for loss or damage.

Approximately 7:30pm as we were working in the basement we noticed the water starting to go down the drain where it had been coming in. For the next several hours, we continued to move things and wet dry vacuum the entire basement.

We made calls to our insurance company, American Family 1800-692-6326- to notify them of the situation and find out what might be covered by our homeowners policy. We were given claim #831-101784. We were told that a claim adjuster would be in contact.

Tuesday, 4-12-11

Both my husband and i had to take time off work to remove carpet, cabinets and water soaked items from the basement. We also went to pick up supplies to clean & disinfect the entire basement due to having sewer back up.

Feltner's Sewer & Drain returned to power rod the main house sewer and remove debris from house lateral. Also suggesting running a camera through to check for additional damages to the lateral, which we declined. The total cost for the work done was \$195.00.

George Novak, Claim Adjuster - American Family, visited us. He took pictures and surveyed the damages caused by the sewer back up. He also gave suggestions on how to sanitize and disinfect the basement. Giving suggestions on what items could be saved and what types of things need to be disposed of. Offering names of restoration companies that we might choose to help with water damage and cleanup. We were told that the damages that we sustained were not covered under our current policy.

Attached is the e-mail letter that George Novak received from Nancy Alvarado, Sewer Program Manager - regarding the sewer clog on South 3rd Street and what action was taken and would be taken to resolve the backup issue.

Wednesday, 4-13-11

Both my husband and i had to take another day off work to complete the basement cleanup.

We feel that the City of Milwaukee is negligent for failure to properly maintain the working order of the main sanitation sewer lines in our neighborhood. In the 23 years that we have lived in our home at 6214 South 3rd Street, we have never had an incident of water in our basement. We had a sump pump failure in 2003, which caused a small amount of clean rainwater to enter the basement. Not even during the most recent heavy rains did we ever have water issues in our basement. When my husband questioned the City crew on site and the operator that he spoke with at 286-2489, about when the sewers were checked or cleaned last, they could not remember or retrieve that information.

We also feel like the boring work being done on the south side of College Avenue (at the top of our hill) also could have contributed to the clogging issue. We were the only affected residence on South 3rd Street. When we questioned the City workers as to why no one else was affected - we were told, that were at the bottom of the hill and our lateral/basement would have to fill up before the next house would be affected. We are thankful to have found the water back up when we did and to have thought quickly enough to start the pumps to keep the water level from damaging more of our basement contents. Although having the sewer water in the basement made for hours / days of extensive cleanup and sanitizing, as well as, the damage of some of our basement items.

We started cleaning on the evening of 4/11/11 and continued to clean the basement and through 4/21/11. We missed 2 days of work for the major bleaching and removal of carpet and other items from our basement.

We are seeking damages and reimbursement for damages as stated.

Feltner's Sewer & Drain returned to power rod the main house sewer and remove debris from house lateral. Also suggesting running a camera through to check for additional damages to the lateral, which we declined. The total cost for the work done was \$195.00.

Basement carpeting/installation 2 estimates provided from:

Stu's Flooring - Basement carpet replacement - Reaction 26 color #745 12x 49 / labor \$ 1892.00 Carpet is replacing the same carpet style and color as previous. (Commercial grade carpet)

Kern's Carpeting - Basement carpet replacement - install/Rec Room glue to concrete. \$1890.00

Sony Home Theatre System Sub-Woofer damaged - water entered the sub-woofer and damaged the internal components and exterior cabinet Purchased 4/9/11 \$99.99

**Baby Crib Mattress - The mattress was stored in plastic under the basement stairs due to the standing water the entire mattress was full of sewer water and had to be disposed of.

Receipt - Pewaukee Mattress purchased 1/6/90 = \$50.95

2 - Tochiere Lamps - Due to the standing water these lamps Purchased 9/8/90 2 @ \$49.90 = \$99.80

Basement Storage Cabinets - Due to the standing sewer water the bottoms of these cabinets started to soak up water and crumble. These cabinets were made of press board and were painted. They held toys, books and videos stored in them.

Receipt - Builders Square purchased 3/25/95 2 cabinets - 70" tall x 16" deep x 36" wide 2 @ 136.49 = \$272.98 2 cabinets - 35" tall x 20" deep x 24" wide. 2 @ 68.99 = \$137.98

Storage Bins Purchased 4/12/11 & 4/16/11- to store items previously stored in the basement cabinets which need to be discarded due to water damage. Walmart 4/16/11 \$95.44

Cleaning Supplies Reciepts - Menards 4/12/11 & 4/16/11 - \$130.18

Reimbursement for time off work - 4/12/11 - 4/13/11

Sandra A Wagner - \$375.00 - See attached pay stub - Paid Full Salary/Seeking 2 days Vacation Time lost Michael J Wagner- \$672.56 - See attached pay stub

Walgreens Photo - Photo processing for claim \$5.24 & \$4.94 = \$10.18

DAMAGES per estimates, receipts & original receipts

Some of the receipts provided are original and we would like the City to take into account that replacement at "today's" costs would be significantly higher. We feel that we are being very modest in our claim. We would like the City of Milwaukee to take into consideration that our quick response of running pumps to minimize the damages, significantly reduced the amount of the claim. Although, we are claiming two full days off work to clean and disinfect the entire area, we feel like this is a modest amount of time, as we did continue to clean and work in the basement for roughly 2 weeks after this incident. We were not covered for any damages on our homeowners policy and received no compensation for any of the damages from any other sources.

Please note that our damages are far greater than this and we are seeking far less than we are .

Besides the monetary loses, we would also ask that the City of Milwaukee check and maintain the main sewer lines in our neighborhood more regularly, so this doesn't happen to us in the future.

We have received your claim in the amount of \$4,032.06, relating to damage allegedly sustained on April 11, 2011 when backwater from the City's sewer backed up into your residence at 6214 South 3rd Street.

Our investigation reveals that the Infrastructure Services Division (ISD) records indicate that on April 11, 2011 they responded to a call of a backwater at this address. They found that the City sanitary main sewer was clogged with grease and other debris. A sewer jet was used to open the clog and restore the sewer to proper working condition. The ISD records also indicated that the sewer is on a regular cleaning schedule and was last cleaned, prior to this incident, on June 28, 2010. Because the sewer is on a regular cleaning schedule and the City did not have notice of problems with the sewer, the City cannot be held liable. Therefore, we are denying your claim.

We have received your claim in the amount of \$1,600.00, relating to the March 25, 2011 death of your dog due to Milwaukee Police Department (MPD) activity at 2151 North 35th Street.

Our investigation reveals and you have agreed that this situation occurred on the date noted above and not March 20, 2011 as stated in your claim. The investigation further reflected that the MPD was investigating and in pursuit of a suspect involved in a shooting and armed robbery. The officers were advised that the suspect went into your home located at 2151 North 35th Street. The officers approached the home and two subjects were observed exiting the property.

Three loose pit bulls were observed in the rear yard. The responding offices were able to corral the dogs back into the home in preparation for securing them. One of the dogs was extremely aggressive and due to the exigency of the circumstances and the possibility an armed suspect was still in the home, the decision was made to extricate the dogs from the home. Since your dog was extremely aggressive and exhibiting attacking behavior toward the MPD personnel, the on-site supervisor approved the actions relating to your dog. The actions taken in this matter were necessary and appropriate. Since the police were not negligent and acting within their sphere of responsibility, the City cannot accept liability and we are denying your claim.
