### License Premise Report

This license premise report is written by PO David LETTEER, assigned to District 5, Late Power Shift Tavern Squad (5468), with PO Russell MACRAE.

On 09-19-20 at 9:39 p.m., we responded to the location of 3200 N. Booth St., Lil Will's Bar, which is a license premise in the city of Milwaukee. We responded to an injured sick complaint at this location.

Upon arrival, Med 18 was leaving with a patient, going to St. Mary's Hospital. PO MACRAE and I spoke to the agent, Lori LIDDELL, who stated she was at the bar, bartending until 7:00 p.m., when a patron, who was drinking left the bar and fell down the front cement stairs, hitting his head. LIDDELL stated the patron was intoxicated prior to coming to the bar and that she had served him two beers. LIDDELL stated after she was done bartending, Raymond NIXON arrived and began bartending. LIDDELL stated NIXON had served him 1 Tequila and water.

While speaking to LIDDELL she appeared visibly intoxicated and stated that the patron was leaving and fell down the stairs. Other patrons in the bar also said the same thing, that the patron fell leaving the bar.

PO MACRAE and I went to St. Mary's and spoke to the patron, Juan BALDARIS (w/m 09-14-41) who stated he was celebrating his birthday and that he was exiting the bar, when he fell down the stairs, striking his head. He was unsure what he struck his head on, but that he did hit something.

BALDARIS did not want anything bad happen to the bar, he is a regular patron there and wanted to make sure that the bar would not be in trouble, seeing as it was his fault for falling.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place virtually on 11/30/2021 at 09:20 AM. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at <http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel>. Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or [stasst5@milwaukee.gov](mailto:stasst5@milwaukee.gov) for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

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## Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
  - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
  - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
  - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
  - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

**Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.**


