This ordinance changes the use classification of self-service storage facilities in various industrial zoning districts from permitted use to special use.

..Body

Whereas, Recognizing some of the unique land use impacts of self-service storage uses, on May 9, 2017, the Common Council adopted File Number 161010, an ordinance that amended the City's zoning code by creating a new use definition for self-service storage facilities and regulating them within certain zoning districts; and

Whereas, On September 21, 2021, the Common Council approved the City of Milwaukee Industrial Land Analysis as an amendment to the Citywide Policy Plan as part of Milwaukee's Comprehensive Plan via File Number 210587; and

Whereas, Self-service storage facilities are currently permitted by right in the industrialoffice, industrial-light, and industrial-heavy zoning districts; and

Whereas, The Industrial Land Analysis called for updates to align the City's zoning code with the goals of protecting and expanding industrial uses with a focus on preserving land for job creation and employment-supporting uses in industrial areas; and

Whereas, Self-service storage facilities can be detrimental to these goals by reducing the amount of land available for job-creating manufacturing uses, potentially detracting from the employment goals of industrial districts; and

Whereas, The number of development proposals for self-service storage facilities has increased in recent years because of their low operational costs combined with socioeconomic trends such as an increase in household relocation and downsizing; and

Whereas, The Common Council seeks to preserve land within industrial zoning districts as locations for family-supporting jobs; and

Whereas, The Industrial Land Analysis recommended restricting self-service storage facilities within industrial districts, while acknowledging that there may be circumstances where self-service storage uses are appropriate, including where the first floor of the

facility is activated with another use, where the self-service storage is proposed for an existing building or site that is not suitable for modern manufacturing or office/residential uses in a district where those uses are permitted, or where the self-service storage may preserve a historically-significant building for another potential future use; and

Whereas, For these reasons, proposals for self-service storage facilities in the industrial-office, industrial-light, and industrial-heavy zoning districts should require special use permits and be reviewed by the Board of Zoning Appeals to ensure protection of public health, safety and welfare; preservation of property; traffic and pedestrian safety; and consistency of the proposed uses with the Comprehensive Plan; now, therefore

The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Milwaukee do ordain as follows:
