Proposal	Retroactive request for a storage shed addition that was already built with dimensions of 18 feet wide, 8 feet high, 4 feet and 4 inches deep.	
Staff comments	A December 1 st inspection indicated that work had been done that required Historic Preservation Commission approval, which had not been obtained.	
	HPC staff took photos of the already built shed addition from the street that shows the addition is visible from the public right-of-way. The new addition's design is not in keeping with the existing character of the brick house and garage. The wood siding shed addition lacks any design features to make it compatible with the main house and garage. These buildings feature applied Italianate ornament. On the main house these include the heavy contrasting cornice, round arch windows, asymmetrical front entrance design, and the full width front porch. The garage uses the same materials as the main house, and complements it with a simple dentil, multi-light windows, paneled door designs, and a flat roof.
