Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

4. On 09/21/2013 Milwaukee police responded to a fight complaint at 2300 West State Street, which was upgraded to a shots fired complaint. Investigation revealed there was a disagreement between patrons while inside the LBJ Club at 2302 West State Street. This became a fight outside the club during which a shot was fired from a handgun by one of the combatants. Milwaukee police incident report #13-264-0016 filed.

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5. On 08/22/2017 officers were dispatched to 2302 W. State St for a Subject with Gun call. The officers located a subject on the street with an AR-15 style weapon and arrested him. The applicant stated she had no problems inside the tavern today. She stated her security guard had observed the subject with gun outside and she immediately locked the business to protect her customers and called the police. The applicant was not able to check the security cameras because she did not have the key to the room where the recorder was located. At 8:00pm the officers returned and checked the surveillance system. It was determined that no video was saved.
6. On 09/17/2017 officers were dispatched to Talk of the Town, 2302 W. State St, for a shooting. Officers located the victim inside the premise with wounds to his shoulder and neck. MFD performed live saving measures but the subject was pronounced dead on scene. The security guard stated he heard a fight outside and someone say something about shooting up the place. He got patrons inside and heard about 14 shots outside. A patron and the security guard then went out to see what was happening. The security guard saw a subject with a long gun running toward the premise, so he went back inside. More shots were heard and the patron stumbled back inside and collapsed. The inside surveillance system was inoperable during the incident.
7. On 10/24/2017 a meeting was held at District 3 regarding the recent incidents at Talk of the Town. The applicant stated the problems were not related to her business but to the people in the neighborhood. The issue of a working camera system was brought up and the applicant stated its not currently working because the system was taken for evidence. She is looking into getting a new system and locating it in an easily accessible location. She stated her old security service was not armed and was not the same person every night. She has gotten a new service which is armed and she has two guards on staff. She closes an hour early at 1:30am since the incident in September. She stated she has had issues with one patron who has been banned after he was seen passing a gun to another patron. He also broke a window a year ago in an attempt to lure a security guard outside. The applicant was advised to look at getting a restraining order.

10. On 08/22/2020 at 11:37pm officers were dispatched to Noise Nuisance complaint at N. 23rd St and W. State St. The caller stated the music was coming from the bar on the corner. The officer arrived and observed people sitting outside of Talk of the Town at 2302 W. State St. with the door open and music coming from inside. The officer advised them of the noise complaint and they turned down the music.

11. On 11/24/21 at 9:54pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 2314 W. State Street for a Shotspotter complaint. Upon arrival, officers observed 2 casings in front of 2302 W. State Street. While investigating the complaint, a subject walked up to officers and asked if they could retrieve his cane from the tavern. The subject told officers that he was inside the tavern when a subject pulled a gun on him and told him and his friend to leave. The subject did not want to report the incident, he just wanted his cane. The applicant was inside the establishment and was unable to work the surveillance system and was uncooperative with the investigation stating that they knew nothing about a gun inside the tavern or shots being fired outside. Officers were unable to view surveillance video of what occurred inside or outside the tavern.

INITIAL INVESTIGATION

This report is written by P.O. Kurt KEMNITZ, assigned to District 3, Late Power Shift.

On Wednesday November 24, 2021 at approximately 9:54pm, Squad 3465, P.O. ALVAREZ and I, were dispatched to 2314 W State St. for a Shotspotter notification of 2 rounds fired(CAD #213282061, IR #213280181). I located 2 casings in front of 2302 W State St., which is a tavern known as "Talk of the Town".

While conducting our investigation regarding the ShotSpotter P.O. ALVAREZ attempted to review video surveillance from the tavern. Inside the Tavern were the licensee, Dyan WARD (b/f, 03/25/1971) and the bartender James WARD (b/m, 01/28/1975).

While conducting a canvas regarding the Shotspotter a citizen approached and asked me to retrieve his walking cane from inside the bar which he forgot after an altercation with someone inside the bar that had pulled a gun on him and his friend telling them to leave. This citizen story was incomplete and did not want to report any criminal behavior regarding the gun however he just wanted his cane and to be on his way.

While reviewing the video surveillance the internet/ power connection to the tv which ALVAREZ was using went out and neither WARD could get it back working. It should be noted that both parties did not try very hard to get the system running, stating they did not know how to work it. Both parties were also not cooperating with the investigation stating they knew nothing about any gun inside the bar and did not hear any shots fired directly outside of the business. James WARD could not give any story of what happened besides a few gentleman "got loud" while playing pool.

We were ultimately unable to view video surveillance of the outside Shotspotter incident or any altercation which may have occurred inside the bar.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place virtually on 01/25/2022 at 09:35 AM. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at <http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel>. Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
