

2. On 05/04/2018 a 16-year-old working in conjunction with the Milwaukee Police and the WI WINS Tobacco Initiative was able to purchase a Mango Swisher Sweet cigar from the clerk at Citgo Gas station, 2627 W. Capitol Dr. The clerk did ask for ID but made the sale anyway. The clerk stated he looked at her ID but thought it showed her old enough so he made the sale. The applicant was issued a citation for the incident.

- 3. On 11/01/19 at 10:36pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 2627 W. Capitol Drive for a fight complaint. Upon arrival, Officers interviewed the caller/employee who stated that 5 to 6 subjects entered the establishment and he thought that they were going to steal items because there have been a lot of thefts as of late. The employee left his secure area, went to the entrance, and tried to get the group to vacate the store. As the individuals were leaving, one of them began to "Shadow Box" in front of the employee causing him to fear for his safety. The individuals then left without further incident and the employee was told by police not to leave his secure area anymore.
- 4. On 06/20/20 at 1:57am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 2627 W. Capitol Drive for a shot spotter complaint. Investigation revealed that two casings were recovered in the parking lot and video surveillance showed a large group of vehicles in the parking lot but the employee did not see or hear anything. The lights to the business interior and exterior where turned on and the doors were locked.
- 5. On 12/19/20 at 11:23pm, Milwaukee Police conducted a license premise check at 2627 W. Capitol Drive. Investigation revealed two cans of coffee and one sandwich which were expired and the employee removed from public view. The business also had unarmed security on site.
- 6. On 04/07/21 at 12:33am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 2627 W. Capitol Drive for a shot spotter complaint. Police dispatch updated the call to 2 people being shot and 20 shots being fired. Police arrived on scene and located two persons that were deceased in the parking lot of the gas station. Additional police arrived to the location to assist on the active scene. Investigators spoke with the store clerk who stated that some subjects were fighting in the gas station. The subjects then moved out of the store to the parking lot of the gas station. The clerk then stated he heard loud noises and people running from the area. Investigators reviewed the video, which showed 2 subjects arguing in the store near the entrance/exit, one of the subjects is armed with a hand gun. During the altercation, a third subject starts arguing with the other 2 subjects. The three subjects exit the store towards the parking lot. Shots are then fired and patrons are observed running from the location.

On 04-07-21 at 12:33 a.m., officers were dispatched to the Citgo Gas Station, located at 2627 W. Capitol Dr. for a report of a shotspotter, with 2 rounds at the gas station. As officer's continued to respond to the gas station, a caller reported there was a person who was shot, with a possible second person shot and 20 gunshots were fired.

Upon officer arrival at the gas station, officer's located two persons who were deceased in the gas station parking lot, along with possibly two other people shot. Officers were also calling for other squads, due to the amount of people and family arriving at the gas station.

I was able to watch the gas station video to see what had occured. Due to this being an active homicide investigation this report will be a general summary of what occurred during this incident.

Prior to the shotspotter, the gas station video shows 3 people entering the gas station store and two of those people begin to argue. One of the two arguing is armed with a firearm. The third person attempts to break up the argument. As the two continue to argue, they move towards the main entrance and exit the store. As the two who are arguing exit the store, another unknown male begins to argue with them. One of the males who was arguing in the store then begins to argue with the unknown male and gunshots are fired, causing other patrons in the gas station parking lot to run out of the lot, so that they would not get shot.

I was able to speak to the gas station clerks. | first spoke to Navdeep SINGH(w/m 11-11-97) who stated just prior to this incident, he felt tired, so he went in to the bathroom to wash his hair and freshen up, in order to wake up. He stated while he was in the bathroom, his co-worker called him and told him something was happening in the parking lot. He stated that he did not see or hear anything because he was in the bathroom.

I spoke to the other clerk, Raman GILL (w/m 05-28-98), who stated some guys came in the gas station and were fighting. He stated that he tried to get the people out of the store and they eventually left the store. When they left the store, the people who were fighting moved to the southern part of the parking lot and he heard loud noises and observed people running from the lot. He stated he locked the doors and kept the people who were in the store from leaving. GILL stated he stayed in the locked cash register area and did not come out of that area.

I was notified on 04-09-21 at 4:00 p.m., that the listed agent Pritpal S. GREWAL was notified by CPU of the license report regarding this incident and that CPU had a discussion with GREWAL about calls for service at the gas station.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place virtually on 01/25/2022 at 11:00 AM. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.

2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)

3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).

4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.

5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

6. You may then provide testimony.

a. Include only information relating to the above license application.

b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.

c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.

d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.

7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.

8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
