There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. This report is written by Police Officer David Novak, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 11/06/2020 officers, along with agents from Wisconsin Department of Revenue, conducted a license premise check at La Casa del Chivolin, 2423 S 6th St. regarding the location operating without licenses. The officer checked LIRA and confirmed the business had applied for licenses but they had not been issued yet. The Wisconsin Department of Revenue agent found the door locked. The agent knocked on the door and placed a to-go food order with the subject that opened the door. He also asked to include beer but was advised they did not have a license for alcohol. The agent was called by phone when the order was ready. The officer and agents entered the business and spoke with the clerk, who stated the business had been operating for about 2-3 weeks for takeout orders. The officers attempted to call the applicant but spoke with his business partner, who admitted to operating without licenses. The applicant was mailed a citation.

INITIAL INVESTIGATION Vodicka, Kevin E 018950

This report is written by P.O. Kevin VODICKA assigned to District Two, Day Shift, Community Prosecution Unit. On Friday, November 6, 2020, at or about 12:30 PM, while assigned to Squad 2166, I conducted a license premises check at "La Casa Del Chivolin", located at 2423 S 6th St in the City and County of Milwaukee, WI, along with Wisconsin Dept. of Revenue special agents Georgeann KING and Mario ALTUZAR. The inspection regarded complaints from business owners and the office of Ald. Jose PEREZ that the location was operating as a restaurant without having first obtained licenses to do so.

A check of LIRA (the City of Milwaukee licensing application) revealed that the location had applied for a Food Dealer, Class B Tavern, and a public entertainment premises on 09/21/20 but that done of the licenses had been granted due to a pending payment, pending police report, and a "Issuance Pending Requirement Met" respectively.

The Facebook page for the restaurant showed that the premises was open from 12:00 PM – 9:00 PM on 11/06/2020 and there were numerous posts that food was available for take-out or delivery. Agent ALTUZAR found the door to the business to be locked and knocked for entrance. The door to the premises was opened and ALTUZAR spoke with a male subject, later identified by WI DL as Francisco ALVAREZ-ESPINOZA (M/W 002/01/78) of 8610 Keri Court Franksville, WI 53126 414-467-9942, who took a to go order and instructed ALTUZAR to pick up the food order at the rear door after he contacted ALTUZAR by phone. ALTUZAR stated that he inquired about adding beers to the order and was told by ALVAREZ-ESPINOZA that the restaurant did not offer them for sale because they didn't have a license to do so.

Shortly after the order was placed ALTUZAR received a phone call to pick up the food. Agents ALTUZAR, KING and I entered the premises and spoke with ALVAREZ-ESPINOZA. ALVAREZ-ESPINOZA stated that the restaurant had been operating for approximately 2-3 weeks, offering take-out food orders, and that the business was operating to pay the rent until the licenses were obtained. A check of the premises did not reveal any alcohol or beer for sale or stored within. ALVAREZ-ESPINOZA stated that his nephew, Luis ALVAREZ (M/W 12/20/94) of 1563 S 58th ST West Allis, WI 53214, is the applicant for the license.

At or about 2:30 pm, I attempted to reach ALVAREZ by phone at 414-544-1517, but reached Floralia TELLEZ-ORTIZ (F/W 05/25/89 of 8610 Keri Ct Franksville, WI) who is listed as a partner in the business. TELLEZ-ORTIZ acknowledged that the business had been operating without having obtained licenses to do so. A citation was mailed to ALVAREZ at his listed address.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place virtually on 01/25/2022 at 01:50 PM. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.

2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)

3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).

4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.

5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

6. You may then provide testimony.

a. Include only information relating to the above license application.

 Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.

c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.

d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.

7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.

8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
