
E STATE ST (DIAGONAL PARKING) - E BRADY ST





Van Buren Option A: One Way Protected Bike Lanes with Turn Lane


E KILBOURN AVE - E STATE ST (SOUTH OF DIAGONAL PARKING) STREET WIDTH: 54'



E STATE ST (DIAGONAL PARKING) – E BRADY ST STREET WIDTH: 60'










Van Buren Option C: Two Way Protected Bike Lane


