
- Established criteria for evaluation of the allocation of American Rescue Plan Act ("ARPA") allocations for housing rehabilitation and new construction
- As it works to continue existing programing and implement new programs using ARPA, DCD has been working to incorporate these measures into both its program and process efforts

1. An evaluation of the project's impact on the surrounding community.



2. An evaluation of the possible displacement of nearby residents prior to commencing housing rehabilitation.

3. Initiatives for workforce development requiring or prioritizing local hiring and local contracting.

4. Initiatives to prioritize owner-occupied homeownership in qualified census tracts, and among the African-American and Latino communities.

5. Strengthening of existing homebuyer readiness programs.



6. For any housing resolution that puts money into existing programs, each program's criteria should be evaluated for unnecessary barriers to applicants.

7. Best efforts to leverage all ARPA allocations.
