Proposal Install Marvin Wood Double Hung 6/1 cottage sash with simulated divided lights

throughout the house.

Staff comments In approximately 2019, Ms. Duncan bought this home from a bank owner that did not

disclose that it was historic. In the meantime, she has been making more urgent repairs at this long neglected home. Ms.Duncan is now prepared begin replacing the windows again. The base product and design is acceptable, but there are two other

options that may have better effect or be cheaper.

Unfortunately no major manufacturer of windows has a line that realistically replicates the leaded panes that previously existed in this home. This is particularly hard to replicate in the world of double pane glass. The wood muntins are proposed

and may be acceptable under these circumstances.

Other situations where this has occurred, we have encouraged the owner to apply lead tape instead of wood muntins. Marvin does have a "leaded" glass option, but online images suggest that it is only between the glass and an unusually dark color.
