Request: Repeat Citation Offenders (February 24, 2021—March 6, 2022).

Data Methods: Repeat stop data was retrieved from the TraCS 10 database and counts distinct stops and distinct citations issued to an individual from February 24, 2021 – March 6, 2022. Criminal histories (summary arrests only) were obtained from the Tiburon Corrections Management System (CMS) and TriTech JailInform databases for each specified crime type.
