This report is written by Police Officer David NOVAK, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

- 1. On 02/02/2022, the applicant was convicted of Intoxicant in Vehicle-Operator.
- 2. On 02/26/2022, officers were dispatched to a Shooting at 1234 S Cesar E Chavez Dr. The officers spoke with the applicant, who was on scene. He stated that he was in the kitchen when he heard a loud bang he suspected was a gunshot. He went into the front of the restaurant and observed one of his employees holding a gun and bleeding from his leg. The applicant took the gun and cleared it as the employee went to the bathroom. The applicant then gave his car keys to a customer to take the employee to the hospital. The applicant did not call the police because the victim had already left for medical treatment. The applicant did provide investigators with video of the incident. The investigation revealed the injury to be self-inflicted.

On Saturday February 26th, 2022, Lieutenant VILJEVAC (Squad, 9310) instructed Detective BRADFORD (Squad,9345) and Detective Shamara GONZALEZ to respond to the scene of an shooting located at 1234 S CESAR E CHAVEZ DR (which is in the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin).

Upon arrival to the scene, Detectives made contact with Jair A. VARELA (W/M,10-27-90) who was sitting inside of Beto's Pizza restaurant. VARELA identified himself as the owner of the business and stated at approximately 1:00AM, he observed an employee of his he identified by the name of Luis LOPEZ-MEJIA who was sitting at the bar. VARELA stated LUIS was sitting next to a mutual friend of theirs who he identified as Jesus, AGUILERA. VARELA stated that LOPEZ-MEJIA ordered food and LUIS had a few tequila shots. VARELA stated throughout the night, he walked back and forth from the front counter to the kitchen filling orders because he is the main cook. VARELA stated at some point after 1:00AM, he was in the kitchen area of the restaurant when he heard (1) loud bang he believed to be a single gunshot.

VARELA stated he came from the back to the front front of the restaurant to see what exactly was going on and that is when he observed LOPEZ-MEJIA who was holding a black semi automatic firearm and bleeding from his right leg. VARELA stated LOPEZ-MEJIA handed him the firearm and ran into the men's restroom all the while blood was dripping from underneath LOPEZ-MEJIA. VARELA stated he observed that the firearm had an obstruction with one of the bullets lodged in its chamber. VARELA stated once he cleared the obstructing bullet, he then removed the magazine and inserted the bullet into the magazine. The firearm was later recovered on top of a freezer inside of the premises.

VARELA stated he observed LUIS exit the men's bathroom and attempt to go into the basement at which point VARELA stated he informed LOPEZ-MEJIA he had to leave the restaurant. VARELA stated he still had and entire restaurant full of customers and LUIS was running around and dripping blood everywhere. VARELA stated he gave JESUS the car key to his silver Dodge Ram pickup truck (PX-9723) to take LOPEZ-MEJIA to the hospital.

VARELA stated while both JESUS and LOPEZ-MEJIA were gone, he continued to run the business as usual and then a short time later, JESUS returned with his vehicle. VARELA stated he didn't think he needed to call the Police and report the incident because LOPEZ-MEJIA had already left and received medical treatment. VARELA provided detectives with video surveillance of the incident.

LOPEZ-MEJIA received medical attention for the gun shot wound and was taken into custody for Felon in Possession of a Firearm and Endangering Safety by use of a Dangerous Weapon.

The above application has been made by the above named applicant(s). This requires approval from the Licenses Committee and the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee. The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place virtually on 4/06/2022 at 9:00 AM. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
