There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. 

Dear Alderman Johnson,

Wendy's on 63rd and Capitol continues to pose problems for the neighborhood.

I had spoken to some of the people managing Wendy's at one of the zoning meetings that were held pre-Covid (Nicole Fernandez, nee Schmit). At that time, I was told that management would keep the alley and area around the restaurant picked up. Initially, this was the case. Unfortunately, long term, management has defaulted on that promise.

I see a thriving business of long lines of cars waiting in the drive through from the moment the doors open, until the time doors close. I am assuming you can provide some kind of clean-up help on a regular basis.

In mid-August of this year, I personally spoke with the daytime manager at Wendy's about the problem, who told me that he would speak to his superior, Mr. Morgan (Valerie Suave and I met Mr. Morgan several years ago on one of our neighborhood walks). On September 10 of this year, our neighborhood group, along with yourself, Todd Miller, and several other City of Milwaukee employees, viewed the said area on a neighborhood walk, organized by the Dineen Park Neighbohood Association. At that time, the problem was noted and addressed verbally.

As I recall, a follow-up phone call or letter was to be forwarded to the owners/operators of Wendy's so that the problem could be resolved. To date, the alley remains full of debris, the overgrown shrubbery still there, with things getting worse instead of better.


We can't expect the social epidemics in our city to improve if the little things do not. To others, this might appear to be a little thing. But to the residents of this neighborhood, it is not.





This report is written by Police Officer Xavier Benitez, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

- 1. On 11/04/2007, a Milwaukee Police Department squad was sent to an armed robbery at the Wendy's 6225 W Capitol Drive. Investigation confirmed that a Robbery had taken place at the Wendy's.
- 2. On 12/19/2007, a Milwaukee Police Department squad was sent to an armed robbery at the Wendy's 6225 W Capitol Drive. Upon arrival spoke to the manager who stated a B/M entered the store and displayed a handgun and demanded and obtained currency.
- 3. On 04/20/08 at 6:18 pm, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 6225 W Capitol Drive for an Armed Robbery complaint. Investigation revealed an armed suspect entered the restaurant and pointed a firearm at one of the employees and demanded money from the register. After the money was obtained the suspect fled. No injuries were reported.
- 4. On 07/27/08 at 7:21 pm, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 6225 W Capitol Drive for an Armed Robbery complaint. Investigation revealed two males, who were armed and masked, attempted to rob the restaurant but as they entered, employees observed them and ran into the managers' office locking the door and calling for police. Nothing was obtained and no injuries were reported.

5. On 11/20/08 at 6:59 pm, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 6225 W Capitol Drive for an Armed Robbery complaint. Investigation revealed three men armed with guns entered the restaurant and demanded money from the cashier. Once money was obtained the suspects fled. No injuries were reported.

6. On 03/12/2009 at 4:36PM, a Milwaukee Police Department squad was dispatched to 6225 W Capitol Dr for an Armed Robbery complaint. An employee stated she observed a suspicious subject come into the restaurant with his hand in his pocket and not order any food. This caused her to believe the restaurant was going to be robbed. She informed the manager and another employee called the police. Nothing was obtained from business.

7. On 07/02/18 at 12:01am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 6225 W. Capitol Drive (Wendy's) for a property damage complaint. Investigation revealed that two employees engaged in an argument, one of which left the restaurant, and punched the drive through window causing it to shatter. A report was filed.

8. On 01/01/21 at 7:31pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 6225 W. Capitol Dr. (Wendy's) for a Reckless Use of Weapon complaint. Officers spoke with the manager of the restaurant who stated that, an unknown male while using the drive thru window of the restaurant intentionally brandished a hand gun and pointed it at one of the employees. Officers spoke with the employee who stated that the incident caused him to fear for his safety. The manger was cooperative and assisted officers with retrieval of the video.

9. On 09/09/2021 at 12:41am officers were dispatched to Shots Fired at Wendy's, 6225 W. Capitol Dr. The officers spoke with the manager, who stated a customer was upset with the cost of his food and he began yelling at her. He hit the drive-thru window with an unknown object and she got the employees into the back of the restaurant. She then heard 5-6 gun shots. She stated no one was hurt during the incident. The manager provided officers with video of the incident.

This report is written by PO Maxwell OURS assigned t District 7, Late Shift.

On Thursday, September 09, 2021, at 12:41 AM, while assigned to Squad 7340 with PO Nicholas GAJEWSKI, we were dispatched to a Shots Fired complaint at 6225 W Capitol Dr, Wendy's, in the City and County of Milwaukee.

Employee Statements

Once on scene I spoke with the manager of Wendy's, identified as Tiquilla M ANDERSON (B/F 07/22/84). ANDERSON stated that she had a customer, suspect 1, make a large order that cost more than \$40. ANDERSON stated that when they came up to the window they had several coupons for their order. ANDERSON stated that normally they only accept 2 coupons per order but she could tell this subject was highly intoxicated and was going to be an issue so she was going to allow more to be used. ANDERSON stated that the discounted price came to about \$27. ANDERSON stated that the subject then became upset and began yelling at her. ANDERSON stated that she told him he could take the coupons back and try at a different Wendy's. ANDERSON stated that the subject got out of the vehicle. ANDERSON stated that she believed the subject hit the window with an unknown object. ANDERSON stated that she told the other employees to go to the back of the restaurant and to get away from the window. ANDERSON stated that while in the back she heard 5-6 gunshots. ANDERSON stated she did not see anything else. ANDERSON stated no one inside the business was hurt during this incident.

I also spoke with another employee, identified as Lyle A SHUMPERT (B/M 04/12/68). SHUMPERT stated he was initially working the window but his manager, ANDERSON, took over for the order regarding the suspect. SHUMPERT stated he observed the suspect yelling at ANDERSON and being disrespectful towards her. SHUMPERT stated that the suspect was grabbing towards ANDERSON and the window. SHUMPERT stated he believed he observed the driver, suspect 1, and the rear driver side passenger, suspect 2, with handguns. SHUMPERT stated that he got away from the window and armed himself with grease if the suspects attempted to gain entry to the restaurant. SHUMPERT stated that he then heard 5-6 shots fired but did not see anything else. SHUMPERT had no further information.

Manager, ANDERSON, provided access to video system and cooperated with the investigation.

The above application has been made by the above named applicant(s). This requires approval from the Licenses Committee and the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee. The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place virtually on 4/06/2022 at 9:10 AM. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
