Our goals for the oriental market would be to provide patrons with an honest, independent customer-focused grocery retail business where they can purchase grocery items and hot prepared food in a commercial kitchen. District 2 serves a large Hmong community for which this oriental market would target as well as that of the general public. The location we have identified in District 2 is in close proximity to residential homes, Hmong American Peace Academy, and funeral homes that are often utilized by the Hmong community. This oriental market will provide the local community with fresh nourishing produce and access to quality food. Items sold at our oriental market include fresh meats, fresh produce, dairy products, and other grocery items typically found in oriental grocery stores. We will not be selling any alcohol related items. Our aim is also to sell locally grown produce from local farmers and wholesale distributors as well as bring in shelf-stable grocery items from Asian countries. Our business will also provide a water refill center and serve WIC and Food Share clients. It is our hope that we would bring friendship, safe neighborhood, and a diverse culture to become an integral part of District 2.
