The Ethics Board respectfully requests that a file be opened to make additions to the 2010 Positions Ordinance.

The Ethics Board, at its October 20<sup>th</sup> meeting, voted unanimously to request that the following positions be required to file statements of economic interests :

Customer Service Representative II .....1

At this same meeting, the Board also voted to request that the Common Council require that members of the Bronzeville Advisory Committee be added to the listing in Section 7. This section requires that members of the listed Boards, Committees and Commissions be required to file a statement of economic interests in accordance with Ch. 303, Milwaukee Code of Ordinances.

The Board reviewed the Milwaukee Code sections relating to the duties and responsibilities of the city employees and the boards and felt these individuals should file Statements under the provisions of s. 303-1-2, Milw. Code of Ordinances.
