There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to attend this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants and partnership applicants must attend or attend by an attorney. The agent or attorney for corporate or limited liability applicants must attend. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition attend the virtual hearing and are willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should request an interpreter attend the meeting with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 12/31/21 at 3:16pm, officers responded to 242 E. Capitol Dr., for a Shooting. Officers were advised a fight had begun between two patrons inside of the business. Upon exiting the restaurant both subjects enter their vehicles, and produce handguns, firing shots at one another. One of the subjects was subsequently shot in the head and was not expected to survive. The employees were cooperative with the investigation and produced video surveillance for the officers.

On Friday December 31, 2021 at approximately 3:16 PM I responded to the Wong's Wok located at 242 E Capitol Dr located in the City and County of Milwaukee, WI as a backing squad

regarding a Shooting call for service.

Synopsis of Event

The victim was identified as **Cal E. LOCK**, **black male**, **10/16/70**. LOCK got into a physical fight with a subject who was later identified as **Deonta L. CHAMPION**, **black male**, **10/23/94**. CHAMPION was captured on surveillance video beating LOCK up inside of the restaurant, before returning back to the driver's seat of the (red in color Nissan Rogue) which he had arrived in originally driving.

CHAMPION'S girlfriend is **Amunique C. GRANT**, **black female**, **01/16/98**, and she works at the Wong's Wok with LOCK. It should be further noted that GRANT and CHAMPION both reside at 3118 W. Wells Street - Apartment #315. A photograph of CHAMPION was observed on GRANT'S Facebook page and he is the same subject that was observed on the restaurant surveillance video fighting with and shooting LOCK.

After CHAMPION beat LOCK up, he returned back to the red Nissan Rogue and entered into the driver's seat of the vehicle. It also appeared on the video that GRANT entered into the passenger side of the same vehicle.

Shortly after entering the red Nissan Rogue, LOCK enters the front passenger door of his 1997 Toyota Camry and he sat on the front passenger seat with the door still open. CHAMPION pulls the red Nissan Rogue behind LOCK'S vehicle and still has the driver's side door open. LOCK produces a handgun and appears to fire at least one shot towards CHAMPION'S vehicle and CHAMPION returns fire in LOCK'S direction, which strikes LOCK to the right side of his head, causing LOCK to drop his handgun. LOCK'S handgun was later recovered and it was a (.380 caliber Highpoint semi-automatic handgun). LOCK was conveyed to Froedtert Hospital for his injuries and he is not expected to survive his injuries.

CHAMPION then drives the red Nissan Rogue out of the parking lot and then west bound on E. Capitol Drive.

Wong's Wok

During the investigation of this incident the Wong's Wok employees were cooperative.

The above application has been made by the above named applicant(s). This requires approval from the Licenses Committee and the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee. The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place virtually on 04/26/2022 at 02:20 PM. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
