Health Care Claims	\$1,750,000		This transfer is necessary for the HMO account to make the December payment for both actives and retirees. 2010 HMO expenditures are greater than anticipated and surpluses from the Claims account, Worker's Compensation, and the Dental program are being utilized to offset the shortage. Total projected 2010 Employee Health Care Benefits expenditures are approximately \$127.9 million. If this transfer is approved, the total amount of funds available will be \$126.2 million. It is likely that a contingent fund transfer will be needed to plug any remaining gap in the health care accounts. The 2010 Worker's Compensation Account is projected to have sufficient funds available to cover year end expenditures with the approval of the \$4.75 million transfer. Additional information is provided to the Committee in a separate memo.
