Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. 3. On 06/09/2021 at 8:38am an officer was parked on the parking lot near 5855 W. Silver Spring Dr. He heard shots being fired close by and observed a subject in the parking lot firing shots toward the McDonald's. The subject dropped his gun and turned himself in to officers. The investigation revealed the subject was inside JAD Foods, 5855 W. Silver Spring Dr. when another subject approached him and made a statement to him. When the subject went outside to get in his car the subject from inside the store started shooting at him. The subject has a valid Carry Concealed Weapon permit and he pulled his gun to return fire. He saw the officer and turned himself in. The officer went in the store and they provided video from inside and outside the store. The video confirmed the suspect approached the victim and had words with the victim. As the victim was attempting to get in his auto the suspect drove by and started shooting at the victim. The video outside also showed the victim return fire and attempt to flag down the officer when he noticed him in the parking lot.

On Wednesday, June 9th, 2021, at 8:38 a.m. I was flagged down by a citizen stating that a black male had pointed a gun at her at the green light on 60th and Silver Spring Drive. The citizen described the male as a B/M, dark-skinned, wearing glasses and a white shirt, and braids braided to the back. The citizen said the male was driving a gray Hyundai Sonata with no plates. The citizen pulled off in her vehicle and did not give me any other information.

I notified the dispatcher I was changing locations to 60th and Silver Spring Drive to locate the subject. I arrived at 60th and Silver Spring and noticed the vehicle parked in front of Jad Foods at 5855 West Silver Spring Drive. The person sitting in the driver's seat matched the description given to me by the citizen.

Squad 4132 (Officer Dale STASZEWSKI and Officer Gerald KRAKER) met me at this location. The subject exited his vehicle to go inside Jad Foods. When the subject left the car, I noticed a black handle of a firearm hanging out his right pocket on his pants. The subject stopped for me when I asked to speak to him. The subject informed me immediately that he was a CCW holder and he had a permit. I explained to the subject that I was informed from another citizen that he had pointed a firearm at her while they were stopped at a red light. I also explained to the subject that he matched the description given to me by the citizen. The subject agreed to provide me his driver's license and CCW permit. The subject was identified by his Wisconsin Drivers license as Nicholas L FLEMING (B/M, 03-05-93) and lives at 5261 North Sherman Boulevard. A check was done for the CCW permit #439637, which was valid and expires 12-22-2024. FLEMING stated he did not point his gun and anyone. The citizen who flagged me down never came to the location to meet me, so FLEMING was free to go.

I moved my squad car and parked on the west side of Auto Zone to type a note to the dispatcher. While I was typing the message on my squad computer, I heard shots that appeared very close. I looked in the rearview mirror of my squad and observed FLEMING shooting his firearm in the direction of Mcdonald's located at 5739 West Silver Spring. I immediately informed the dispatch of the shots being fired and asked for more squads. I exited my vehicle, and FLEMING dropped his firearm in front of him and immediately put his hands in the air.

FLEMING stated he was getting in his car and a person driving a red Volkswagon started shooting at him. FLEMING stated he did not know the person. FLEMING stated while he was in Jad Foods, the subject approached him and said, "what was all that shit you was talking about earlier, talk that shit now!" FLEMING stated he did not know what the subject was talking about and bought his items and left the store. While I was talking to FLEMING, he noticed the red Volkswagon driving westbound on Silver Spring Drive and pointed the vehicle out to me. I described the vehicle over the squad radio and observed the vehicle turn northbound on 63rd Street. FLEMING described the person shooting at him as a B/M, 5'10, dark complexion, dreads, wearing a light blue button-down shirt.

I went inside Jad Foods, and the worker allowed me to watch the video from inside and outside the store. The video inside the store showed the subject say something to FLEMING, and FLEMING responded, but there was no sound. The video also allowed me to get a better description of the subject. The subject on the video which I saw shooting was a B/M, 5"10 dark complexion, medium build, dreads in a ponytail, wearing glasses, light blue button-down work shirt with company name affixed to

the shirt, and an American flag on the left sleeve, light-colored shorts, and multi-colored air max Nikes. I observed the subject buy ice and exit the store. The subject entered a red Volkswagon parked on the lot and placed the ice in the back seat. I observed FLEMING leave the store and walk to his vehicle. As FLEMING was attempting to enter his vehicle, the subject from the red Volkswagon started shooting at FLEMING. FLEMING fired shots back at the red Volkswagon. FLEMING retreated toward the Auto Zone and noticed I was sitting in the lot, and motioned for me to come to him.

This case is pending.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place virtually on 06/06/2022 at 09:25 AM. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at <http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel>. Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.


