This report is written by Police Officer Monreal, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

- 1. On 09/09/2018 officers were dispatched to a fight at Tu Casa, 3710 W. Lincoln Av. When the officers arrived they found security had two subject detained. The subject were intoxicated and refused to leave the bar. When they were being escorted out they made threats to security, which is why security detained them. The applicant was on scene and stated she just wanted the subjects to leave. The subjects were told to leave and were banned from the property.
- 2. On 12/14/2018 at 1:57am officers were dispatched to shots fired at Tu Casa, 3710 W. Lincoln Av. The officer interviewed the applicant who was on scene. She stated there was a verbal argument in the tavern earlier at about 1:00am but they closed the tavern to avoid further conflict. She did not hear gunshots. The applicant's husband, Marcos ISIDORO-GAMBOA, stated he was outside at closing and there were two fights outside but he did not hear any gun shots. The sole security guard stated she attempted to use pepper spray to stop the fights and did hear about 5 gunshots. The officer watched the security footage which showed about 40 subject exiting and arguing. He observed one subject exit the tavern and engage in a verbal argument. During the argument the subject produced a firearm and pointed at the other subject. The subject with the gun left in a car and then subjects on scene were observed ducking. No one from bar called the police. The applicant was cooperative and was advised to call the police in the future if something happens at the bar.

- 3. On 01/27/2019 officers were dispatched to Tu Casa, 3710 W. Lincoln Av for a Trouble with Subject. Marcos ISDORO was on scene and stated that a subject was denied entry due to his dress code and as he was leaving he threatened to shoot the tavern up. ISIDORO requested the officers stay in the area in case the subject returned.
- 4. On 02/12/2019 a meeting was held at District 2 regarding Tu Casa, 3710 W. Lincoln Av regarding shots fired on 12/14/2018 and an abduction on 01/01/2019. At the meeting was the applicant; her husband, Marcos ISIDORO; and owners of Midwest Private Police Inc. ISIDORO stated the shots fired was not related to his business because it happened outside and down the street. He didn't call police because someone else said they were calling. He was advised that he was responsible for his patron's action outside as well as inside and he should not have his patrons parking in the parking lots of neighboring businesses. Regarding the abduction ISIDORO stated he was asked by a patron to look at video for whom the abducted patron left with and he advised that person to call the police. He stated he then allowed the police to view the surveillance video.

5. On 07/29/2019 at 12:45am officers were dispatched to Tu Casa Restaurant, 3710 W. Lincoln Av for a Battery compliant. The victim stated she was at the bar and her ex-boyfriend hit her to the face. The business was cooperative and provided video of the incident.

- 6. On 12/20/2019 at 2:11am officers were dispatched to Tu Casa, 3710 W. Lincoln Av, for a Trouble with Subject. The officers spoke with security, who stated there were two males in the restaurant refusing to leave at closing. After they left the security guard heard 5-6 gunshots. The officers checked the area but did not locate the subjects. The manager stated he did not witness the incident but did provide video of the subjects leaving.
- 7. On 01/01/2020 at 3:31am officers were dispatched to a fight at 3710 W. Lincoln Av. The officer spoke with security who stated two subjects had an argument. One subject left and the other was argumentative with security, who placed the subject in handcuffs and called police. The manager was cooperative with the officers.
- 8. On 01/29/2020 at 1:00am officers were dispatched to a Subject with weapon complaint at 3710 W. Lincoln Av. The officers spoke with security who stated two females were fighting. One of the females was still on scene. She confronted a female who had an affair with her husband. She pushed the subject to the ground. The security guard used pepper spray to stop the fight and one of the subjects left the scene. The applicant was on scene and requested the female be issued a no trespassing order.
- 9. On 02/16/2020 at 1:22am officers were dispatched to a fight at 3710 W. Lincoln Av. Upon arrival they were told two females were fighting. Both females were on scene and appeared to be intoxicated. The subjects did not want to prosecute and were released.

10. On 09/0720 at 12:25am, officers were dispatched to a Subject with a Gun at 3710 W. Lincoln

Av. Officers were advised an altercation occurred between security and a patron. The patron who was heavily intoxicated was being asked to leave the bar, at which time the patron struck the security guard multiple times in the face with a closed fist. Management was on scene and was cooperative with police.

- 11. On 10/04/20 at 2:25am, officers were flagged down by security at 3710 W. Lincoln Av., for a fight. Officers observed approximately 20 patrons standing outside and began to disperse as officers arrived. A victim was observed on the ground and stated he was punched, however, did not know who hit him and did not wish to be a victim. The manager was on scene and stated he had approximately 50 patrons and 2 security guards. The manager denied knowledge of a fight outside and was advised to have more security when he has a crowd of that size. Management was cooperative and allowed police to view video surveillance, however, the fight was not captured.
- 12. On 05/04/21 at 8:33pm, officers along with an agent from Department of Revenue conducted a license premise check at 3710 W. Lincoln Av. All receipts and records of alcohol purchases were provided and valid. No violations were found and the agent was cooperative with police.
- 13. On 04/23/22 Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 3710 W. Lincoln Av., for a Subject with Weapon. Officers were advised a patron attempted to take beer outside of the establishment. Security stopped the patron and an argument ensued, escalating to security eventually using pepper spray on the patron. Employees were cooperative and allowed officers to view video surveillance of the incident.

This License Premise Report is typed by P.O. Misael VASQUEZ, Assigned to District Two, Squad 2320, and Late Shift.

On Saturday, April 23, 2022 at 1:18 AM P.O. Kevin FREY and I were dispatched to 3710 W Lincoln Ave (Tu Casa) for a subject with weapon call.

Upon arrival, I spoke with the caller IBARRA, Carlos (M/W 08-08-84) who stated he was at Tu Casa when the security guard RODRIGUEZ, Edwin (M/W 04-15-94) used unnecessary force and pepper sprayed him. IBARRA stayed he had got into an argument with RODRIGUEZ for trying to take beers outside and RODRIGUEZ then pepper sprayed him for no reason.

I then spoke with RODRIGUEZ (the security guard), who stated he saw IBARRA trying to walk out with beers but then stopped him at the door. RODRIGUEZ stated IBARRA was hostile and when IBARRA'S girlfriend tried to calm him down he pushed her out of the way. RODRIGUEZ stated he told IBARRA to keep his hands off his girlfriend and stop trying to take beers outside. RODRIGUEZ stated IBARRA continued to advance on him and pulled RODRIGUEZ by the shirt twice to draw him in close, RODRIGUEZ stated he believed IBARRA was going to punch him because IBARRA would not back up, and keep pulling him in so RODRIGUEZ pepper sprayed IBARRA and then escorted him out.

The manager, ISIDORO, Marcos (M/W 01-22-79) was very cooperative and allowed officers to review camera footage that captured the incident. The footage

showed IBARRA trying to leave with beers outside, when he is stopped by RODRIGUEZ. IBARRA then continues to escalate the situation and get in RODRIGUEZ'S face. IBARRA also pulls RODRIGUEZ towards him and that is when RODRIGUEZ pepper sprays IBARRA. All staff and owners were cooperative through out the whole investigation. ISIDORO did not want anything done citation wise for IBARRA he just wanted him removed for the night.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place virtually on 06/07/2022 AT 10:55 AM. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
