There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to attend this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants and partnership applicants must attend or attend by an attorney. The agent or attorney for corporate or limited liability applicants must attend. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition attend the virtual hearing and are willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should request an interpreter attend the meeting with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

This report is written by Police Officer Corstan D. COURT, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

- 1. On 01/07/2021 an officer received an email from a citizen regarding and incident at Up Down MKE, 615 E. Brady St., on 01/02/2021. The citizen stated his son was at the bar and got into an argument with another patron and that patron pointed a gun at his son. The citizen attempted to contact the bar but received no response. The officer advised the citizen his son should file a police report. The citizen stated his son was reluctant to file a report. The officer went to the bar to speak with the day shift manager about possible security footage. The manager stated he had no knowledge of an incident occurring. He texted the night manager who stated someone had watched the video and did not observe a gun. On 01/14/2021 the officer received an email from the bar. The email contained a copy of a video from 01/02/2021. The video showed two groups of people in an argument outside the bar. The parties separate and walk off in different directions.
- 2. On 03/09/2021 officers conducted a license premise check at The Up Down, 615 E. Brady St. The bartender provided the tavern licenses and her Class D Operator's license. The employees were cooperative.

3. On 03/04/22 at 12:17am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 1672 N. Jackson Street fro a theft which occurred at 615 E. Brady Street. Investigation revealed that the caller left her jacket on a coat rack inside the tavern and when she returned, items were missing for her jacket. Officers interviewed the manager of the establishment who was extremely helpful and told officers that there were no cameras pointing at her jacket but he will look through surveillance video to see if he could see any suspects.

INITIAL INVESTIGATION

This report was written by P.O. Jacob ROECKER, assigned to District One, Late Shift.

On Friday, March 4th, 2022 at 12:17 AM (WHILE IN FULL DUTY UNIFORM EQUIPPED WITH AN ACTIVATED AXON BODY WORN CAMERA AND OPERATING A MARKED BLACK IN COLOR MILWAUKEE POLICE SQUAD CAR, SPECIFICALLY SQUAD 118) I was dispatched to a Theft complaint at the address of 1672 N. Jackson St. The caller stated that she hung her coat up on a coat rack while inside of the bar and when she came back to her coat, several items were missing. This incident occurred in the City and County of Milwaukee, in the State of Wisconsin.

Upon arrival I observed a group of approximately 6-7 people standing on the sidewalk who flagged me down in the 1600 block of N. Jackson St. I met with the victim, identified as Emily A. WITHAAR (w/f, 09/14/1999), who stated that she and her friends were at the Up Down Bar, located at 615 E. Brady St, earlier in the night. WITHAAR and the others stated that they arrived at the bar at approximately 11:05 PM. WITHAAR stated that she hung her coat up on the rack provided by the bar upon entering the bar. WITHAAR stated that around approximately 12:00 AM she went to her coat and observed that several items were missing from her coat.

I then went to the Up Down Bar, located at 615 E. Brady St to check for video footage of the incident. I was met at the front door by the one of the managers of the bar who stated he traded contact info with WITHAAR. The manager stated that he did not have any cameras directly pointing out to the coat rack and would comb through the video to check for any subjects leaving the bar with extra items in their hands and contact WITHAAR regarding his findings.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place virtually on 07/18/2022 at 09:25 AM. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
