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This resolution(220391) is relative to the allocation and the acceptance and funding of the year 2021 Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act ("CARES Act") (Pub. L. No. 116-136) for Emergency Solutions Grant-CV through the Community Development Grants Administration

The Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) program provides grant funding to (1) engage homeless individuals and families living on the street, (2) rapidly re-house homeless individuals and families, (3) help operate and provide essential services in emergency shelters for homeless individuals and families. and (4) prevent individuals and families from becoming homeless.

These funds from the U.S Department of Housing and Urban Development addresses Milwaukee residents who are experiencing homelessness or are at a high threat of becoming homeless.

The concentration of services shall center around agencies and organizations providing COVID-19 services that:
