# PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE DECEMBER 9, 2010 Item 18, File #100843

File Number 100843 is a resolution authorizing the Police Department to accept an additional \$25,000 in Organized Crime Drug Enforcement Task Force Grant funding from the U.S. Department of Justice, Federal Bureau of Investigation.

### **Background**

- The U.S. Department of Justice, Federal Bureau of Investigation, periodically awards
  Organized Crime Drug Enforcement Task Force ("OCDETF") Grant funds to the Milwaukee
  Police Department to fund MPD overtime for assistance in specific OCDETF investigations
  and prosecutions.
- 2. The Police Department was awarded \$20,000 in OCDETF Grant funding for the period extending from October 1, 2009, through September 30, 2010. Since the award amount did not exceed \$20,000, no Common Council resolution was required to authorize application for and acceptance of funding.
- 3. The Police Department appears to be eligible for an additional \$25,000 in OCDETF Grant funding for the 10/1/09-9/30/10 period to fund overtime for assistance with a specific case (Investigation #GL-WIE0147). This resolution is necessary because the total grant award now exceeds \$20,000.

## **Discussion**

- This resolution authorizes the Police Department to apply for, accept and expend
  Organized Crime Drug Enforcement Task Force Grant funds totaling \$45,000 from the from
  the U.S. Department of Justice, Federal Bureau of Investigation.
- 2. The grant period for this grant extended from October 1, 2009 through September 30, 2010.
- 3. No local/City match is required for this grant-funded project.
- 4. Grant proceeds will fund MPD overtime for assistance in specific OCDETF investigations and prosecutions.

### Fiscal Impact

Acceptance of this grant funding requires no City participation and has no impact on the tax levy.
