





Straight Flashing is a Short-Cut



The common mistake among general contractors is installing the wrong type of flashing. Straight flashing also called L-flashing is a shortcut around chimneys. Step flashing creates a better more lasting seal than L-flashing. L-flashing is faster to install and allows contractors to cut corners and



cost. Straight flashing wraps around the base then shingle are installed over top.
