I am sending a letter referring to Ms. Lorraine McNamara-McGraw's attempt to dox me, and others. I noticed that she sent a letter that is now in the public record regarding my address and claims that I "might live in Brookfield." I live in Milwaukee (as I stated, a pretty new transplant), in a multi-story old brick building - you know, the kind of building very similar to the Hackett proposal.

I think this behavior is deeply disturbing on Ms. McNamara-McGraw's part. For my part, I am not wild about dropping my address willy-nilly after I have had on-and-off recurring nightmares about being stalked and killed for over a decade following trauma, and I don't need to add Ms. McNamara-McGraw to that list of people interested in harassing me. I cannot believe it's some simple and reasonable housing proposals that are getting me to this point, but the city needs to take a firm stand against citizens attempting to dox and harass people who come out with opinions on a matter - regardless of which way they stand.

Ms. McNamara-McGraw, this is a formal request to immediately stop all attempts to dox and harass me (and frankly, others). I request that Ms. McNamara-McGraw does not respond to this email, nor initiate any individual communication with me, and doing so will be considered harassment.

The City Plan Commission is welcome to add this as an additional letter and a direct rebuttal to Ms. McNamara-McGraw's claims. I am sure that city staff can find my address, although I would be happy to share that privately if not. Clearly, I do not feel safe attaching it to this proposal.
