There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to attend this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants and partnership applicants must attend or attend by an attorney. The agent or attorney for corporate or limited liability applicants must attend. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition attend the virtual hearing and are willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should request an interpreter attend the meeting with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

#### The Chi Lounge 2000 S 13th St

- 7/28/2021: New Class B Tavern, Food Dealer, and PEP applications requesting Disc Jockey, Patron Contests, Patrons Dancing, 1 Pool Table, Movie Projector was filed.
- 11/9/2021: The application was held in Committee to allow time for the applicant to engage nearby residents. Ald. Perez had received one complaint that was not part of the file and had was concerned that he had not heard from neighbors that were in support
- 1/5/2022: The application was amended in committee to close at midnight Sundays through Thursdays and recommended for approval.
- 1/18/2022: The application was granted by the Common Council. At this point all of the requirements for issuance were met aside from payment of the license fees. The licenses were not issued.
- 2/21/22: The License Division was notified by the Milwaukee Police Department that there was after set activity occurring at the premises and that it was operating as an unlicensed tavern.
- 3/1/22: I spoke with the applicant by phone to advise her that the licenses were not issued but we were receiving reports that the bar was open. She said that she was unaware that someone was operating the bar but wanted to keep the application because she was looking to transfer it to a different location. When advised that she would need to go through the same approval process as a new application she stated that she would withdraw.
- 3/2/22: The applicant withdrew.
- 3/3/22: There was a conversation with a new potential applicant however an application was never filed.
- 4/6/22: The original applicant, Ms. Ewan, filed another application to operate the bar.

On 07/14/2019 at 12:47am officers were dispatched to a Shots spotter call at 1980 S 13<sup>th</sup> St. The officers could not locate any casings and interviewed security at 2000 S 13<sup>th</sup> St, El Pacifico Night Club. He stated three subjects were denied entry because one subject had a gun. Security thought they could be the ones who fired shots. The officers viewed the video of the incident which showed the subjects being denied because one had a gun. The subjects were then observed getting in a car and driving off. At s 13<sup>th</sup> St and W. Roger St it appears the passenger fires a gun in the air, because citizens were observed running away from the area. No tavern violations were observed.
- 4. On 12/14/2019 at 2:41am officers conducted a licensed premise check at La Pacifica Night Club, 2000 S 13<sup>th</sup> St. When the officers entered they observed 12 people at the bar drinking beer. The bartender, Uriel LOPE-LUZ, stated he was the manager and was leasing the bar. He did not have a manager's license and was not aware that a licensed bartender needed to be on the premise during hours of operation. The stated he knew closing time was 2:30am on weekends but was just waiting for his patrons to finish their beers. He stated this would not happen in the future because the owner asked to close the bar indefinitely.

There are "tavern rules" signage affixed to the front entrance, listing the dress code, age restriction, patron code of conduct, etc.




# City Concentration Map

The above application has been made by the above named applicant(s). This requires approval from the Licenses Committee and the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee. The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place virtually on 09/07/2022 at 11:15 AM. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

# Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.






