There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to attend this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants and partnership applicants must attend or attend by an attorney. The agent or attorney for corporate or limited liability applicants must attend. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition attend the virtual hearing and are willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should request an interpreter attend the meeting with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

I'm unable to attend the meeting tomorrow about this bar situation as I am recovering ^ '. I'm very fatigued when I get home and usually don't feel good.

But I do want you to know and the new owners to know that we aren't in favor of this because of the following reasons and concerns. They can say and make promises all they want but after they get their license, we feel they may break any promises they make, and then we have to deal with calling police or contacting you to stop

whatever they are doing. We feel a good family restaurant is what we need and would like....This is a family orientated neighborhood with children on this block as well.

Here are our reasons for "NOT" having this bar or any bar...

- 1. No Music Outside.
- 2. No Littering/broken beer bottle and liquor bottles on residents lawns.
- 3. No Urinating on our properties.
- 4. No loud music coming from cars parked in front residents homes.
- 5. No drug using and or selling in front of residents homes.
- 6. No SPEEDING (25mph) on 8th Street at all hours of operation.
- 7. No cigarette butts in the street and on residents lawns.
- 8. Last bar had vehicles parked on the grass behind the bar, it looked like a parking lot at times. Can't vehicles on grass.
- 9. Residents have a hard time finding parking in front of their homes or we have to park up the block or on Euclid. That's NOT fair to the people who pay rent and or mortgages.

We believe in 3 strikes your out and as we see it right now, they are already past 3 strikes to even open this bar.

We have lived here since and are very aware of our neighborhood. We are working class people who go to bed to be able to get up early to get to work. We don't need the noise, frustration and disturbance that this bar or any bar would bring to this neighborhood.

Please let this be known and we do appreciate the feed back from you, the new bar owners as well.

We hope you put the neighbors first here and again a good family restaurant would be much better for 8th Street and this area we live closer to but we can still see and hear what goes on at that location.

Hello Marina,

My name is ____ and I live bar that is being proposed on Oklahoma. I cannot attend the meeting tomorrow but would like to express my concerns. I normally don't get involved or speak up about things like this, but this one is important to me.

Please let me start by saying that love our little neighborhood. We love the diversity and community that this area provides. We've lived here for 4 years, 3 of them we rented from the bar . We've just celebrated our first year in a home We've met so many lovely people by participating in community events like neighborhood clean ups and just by frequently walking the heighborhood with our 2 dogs. I minored in Spanish and it has been an amazing area to connect with neighbors and practice the language. We hope to raise our children here and this bar would be a major concern for that.

Our neighborhood is a family oriented neighborhood. There are plenty of families and small children who

live within houses of this bar proposal. One of our neighbors just had their 5th baby. Our neighbor

neighbors who we are so excited to have here. We love and care about our neighbors and they have all expressed similar concerns.

In the past, this bar location has brought nothing but chaos. One night I woke up at bar close to a giant, large crowd street fight. Women were yelling, cars were in the middle of the street with all 4 doors open, men were holding people back, earrings and hair were being ripped out... In addition, yards get filled with litter/beer bottles/glass shattered on the ground, and the noise makes it really difficult to go to sleep. With bar close being at 2am here in WI, that noise would be constant for us. Not to mention the addition of live music, djs, and karaoke. Those speakers are so loud, as well as the noise that people bring at bar close (loud screaming/woohooing/fighting). Fireworks are already a loud hazard in our area that rarely ever gets addressed—we really don't need more noise.

Other times we've seen people peeing on our neighbors lawn. Not to mention the drunk driving that happens.

I've seen people who can barely walk get into their cars.

While I recognize that this bar will have a different owner and will not be the same exact as the past, my concerns are that it will bring in the same exact loud, irresponsible, disrespectful crowd. Add alcohol into the mix and it just makes it a place that families stress and worry about. These are all things that I'm sure you wouldn't want just a few houses down from your own home. I can't imagine trying to get a baby to sleep or keeping toddlers asleep with this.

With this long list of concerns, I ask that you not hand out the licenses being requested. It has been so nice to have the neighborhood quieter again. We ask that you help to keep it the way it is. Something that I would love to see in this space would be a lovely coffee shop, a restaurant, a nice cocktail lounge—anything that isn't open

until bar close or that's requesting permission to have loud music.

Thank you for reading this and I hope that you will seriously consider these concerns.



To whomever it may concern,

I am reaching out in regards to the license application for El Relajo Bar on 733 W Oklahoma Ave, and would like to contribute an objection to the aforementioned application.

I am a resident of the neighbouring area 'to to the business—and have been for several years now—and am of the firm impression that the locale of choice for this business is unideal. Every morning without fail, the neighbourhood is made aware that El Relajo Bar is closing for the day; the customer-base often lingers outside causing racket for what can be hours on end, between shouting, revving their engines, racing along the streets in close quarters, and even harassing those of us who work third shift hours and are forced to go outside at this time. I have been made to feel like my safety is compromised on several occasions, with groups of men harassing me and following me to my vehicle when I am parked on the street. And on my off-days when I don't have to be up at these hours, I am often awakened by the patrons flooding our area before eventually dispersing—though never quietly.

Coincidentally, many vehicles on our block have been broken into with increasing frequency with the emergence of El Relajo Bar. I have no evidence that connotes a link between the two, though given the behaviour I have seen from many of the customer-base of El Relajo Bar, it would not necessarily surprise me.

Several months ago, I also had a peculiar incident where several women's purses were discarded along the walkway of my home. Empty as far as money goes, but still with identification cards, makeup, and other such amenities. I had turned them over to the Milwaukee Police Department and have since not heard anything further of the incident. Nothing of a similar nature has happened since that initial instance, however the circumstance in and of itself is something I continue to think about and I find very unsettling.

I feel if this license is permitted to this business, the noise complaints will persist more than ever, and further incidents will occur that bring myself and other women great discomfort. The location of El Relajo Bar should not be in such a condensed residential area if it wishes to expand its repertoire, and I am certain I am not the only resident that shares this sentiment.

Thank you for your time, as well as the opportunity to dispute the grant of this license.

I object to a license being given to the applicant: Arturo Albiterto who owns the bar, El Relajo at 733 W. Oklahoma Avenue.

This bar has been a problem in our area between 6 & Oklahoma and surrounding neighborhoods as well as has compromised safety to those that live close by. The customers that go to this bar urinate outside and have thrown bottles in the sidewalks and into the flowers or plants that neighbors work so hard to grow so they can keep their yards beautiful and clean.

Neighbors usually have to sweep and clean up the glass from sidewalks and grass per their statement to me since I go to the Safety Meetings and they feel comfortable telling me this. I have seen the mess these clients leave behind as well and reported it to District 6 too.

The other problem is the nuisance of loud music and screams of drunk people acting like fools and speeding away in their cars as they leave at late hours of the night while neighbors who work different shifts and on the weekends are trying to sleep, but are awakened due to the nuisance and noise. We do not feel safe with this bar around and do not want it in our neighborhood.

Terri here. Nice to meet you today. Leif, wanted to e-introduce you to Arturo Albiter, who is applying for a license for the old Relajo on 7th and Oklahoma. Thought you two might want to set up a time to connect. They purchased the building recently and are beginning to apply for their new bar license. Juan Magdaleon, who is opening Tulum in the old Odd Duck space, is assisting him as he just went through this process as well.

Arturo, Leif runs the Crisol Corridor Business Improvement District. It covers S 13th from Cleveland to Morgan, and Oklahoma from S 15th to Chase, so your business is in this BID. Leif can connect you with other business owners and give you information about what security and beautification grants you may be eligible for if you're looking to improve the property. https://crisolcorridor.org/business-grants/

For background, this bar unfortunately has a recent history of patrons drinking either in the bar or in their cars outside and then having loud and violent fights, sometimes involving guns or vehicular assault. In one instance a grandmother was lying down with her ill grandchild on the couch and a bullet came through the window over their heads. In another, a drunk patron fought with 5 other people in the street, punched them and then got into his car and began to crash his car into all of the surrounding cars over and over.

The 53215 zip code is extremely dense population wise. We have the highest population per capita and the greatest concentration of children in Wisconsin. This is a majority-minority community of refugees and immigrants who have made sacrifices to have a safe and welcoming place for their children to play and for their families to sleep at night. Many of them also own businesses. We simply cannot have the kind of activity we were seeing here before. We are eager to see an effort to offer a responsible and friendly establishment that the neighbors and patrons can enjoy and feel comfortable living next to.

On Wednesday, April 13, 2022 at 4:00 pm, my partner PO Michael Ward and I, met with business owner/licensee Arturo Albiter. Mr. Albiter stated that he bought the property and hopes to open for business as soon as the licenses are approved. Mr. Albiter stated he plans to be open Tuesday, Thursdays, Fridays, and Saturdays and his wife and him will be on premise on days that they are open.

The business is elevated and can be difficult to see from the outside of the business into the inside. The location does have minimal signage on the windows and you can easily see from the inside of the location to the outside. The location does have 15 surveillance cameras, 7 of which are located on the exterior and 8 interior cameras. Mr. Albiter stated he plans on upgrading the cameras and possibly installing more cameras throughout the business.

Mr. Albiter stated that he will have 3 unarmed security personnel at the bar on Thursday through Saturday. Mr. Albiter stated that they have wand detectors that will be used by security personnel to check patrons as they enter the bar. A dress code will be enforced and ID's will be checked at the front door as well.




City Concentration Map 733 W OKLAHOMA AVE

- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.


