		The City's Lviing Wage applies to all non-professional service contracts above \$5,000. The current Living Wage is set at \$12.21 per hour. The City requires that City employees be paid a minimum of \$15 per hour.				
		This ordinance would provide for the same minimum rate of pay for contracts executed by DOA - Purchasing as paid to City employees. The majority of contractors' employees already earn at least \$15 per hour. However, approximately 38% of vendors have at least one employee making less than \$15 per hour.				
F		An increase in the Living Wage would increase wages for approximately 74 employees at an average of \$1.30 per person per hour. The fiscal impact for vendors who would be required to increase wages averages approximately \$5,000 annually. Similarly, two SBE vendors would be impacted by the increase (11 employees at an increase average of \$1.73 per hour per person).				
		The total fiscal impact for all vendors and SBE vendors increasing wages would be \$64,000 annually. This calculation assumes the cost to the vendors would be passed along to the City.				
	Assumptions used in arriving at fiscal estimate	The timeframe for which this ordinance woud be in effect would be approximately 3 months. Accordingly, the estimated financial impact is \$16,000. (64,000 / 12 = 5,333.33. 5,333.33 x 3 = \$16,000).
