



Community Medical Services offers substance use treatment programs that include outpatient medicationassisted treatment, individual counseling, and group counseling.

On a community level, we provide no-cost educational in-services on how to integrate medication-assisted treatment into your existing programs or partnerships.

OUR APPROACH IS BASED ON CURRENT SCIENCE AND EVIDENCE, WHICH CONCLUDES THAT OUTPATIENT MEDICATION-ASSISTED TREATMENT, ALONG WITH COUNSELING SERVICES, IS THE MOST EFFECTIVE FORM OF TREATMENT FOR INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE EXPERIENCING SUBSTANCE USE NEEDS.

**90%** of individuals served by CMS who reach the 2-year mark in treatment consistently test negative for opiate use.

**1/3** of all CMS patients are being tapered off of methadone at any given time.
