Good Afternoon Chris and Tea,

Regarding the budgetary reductions' impact on the MFD, it'll ultimately amount to a total reduction of thirty (30) FTEs, although, fifteen (15) would not be slated to occur until mid-year. Of the positions slated for reduction, it includes a proportionate reduction in supervisory roles, as each company structurally has a set number of supervisors by design. Below is how it pans out:

- 1st Decommissioned Fire Company (January 1) 3 Supervisors : 12 Firefighters
 - o -1 Captain
 - o -2 Lieutenants
 - o -3 Heavy Equipment Operators
 - o -9 Firefighters
- 2nd Decommissioned Fire Company (July 1) 3 Supervisors : 12 Firefighters
 - o -1 Captain
 - o -2 Lieutenants
 - o -3 Heavy Equipment Operators
 - o -9 Firefighters

This results in a perfectly proportionate reduction where supervisory personnel to HEOs and Firefighters are concerned. The remaining companies would be of the exact same proportions. Is this the level of depth Chair Dimitrijevic is seeking?

To: All Department Heads From: Ald. Marina Dimitrijevic, Chair, Finance and Personnel Committee Re: Effect of Proposed Budget Cuts on Departmental Supervisory Ratios

As we, collectively, prepare for our annual budget process, I want to thank all of you for the work you've done getting us this far. These are difficult times and your efforts are noted and appreciated.

One issue that my colleagues and I have been discussing is the effect proposed staffing reductions may have on the ratio of supervisors to those they supervise in your departments. My respect for front-line workers is a matter of record, and I think it is very important that we demonstrate to our co-workers and our citizens that whatever reductions we are deliberating are made in consideration of the work they do and the effect that their loss would have on our ability to deliver necessary services to the public.

With that in mind, please submit, in writing, for every area of your department in which reductions are contemplated, a current account of the ratio between supervisors and those supervised and what that ratio would be if the reductions were implemented. These may be submitted to both Chris Lee (clee@milwaukee.gov) and Tea Norfolk (Tea.Norfolk@milwaukee.gov). At a minimum, I would ask that you be prepared to discuss these ratios at your budget hearing, but it would be better if these accounts could be had 24 hours in advance.
