2023 Budget Summary

- 1. 2023 Proposed Budget: \$116.8 million
 - \$86.8 million in anticipated grants
 - \$30 million in unanticipated grant authority
- 2. Seven departments anticipate operating grant funding in 2023
- 3. 54 separate anticipated grants
- 4. \$1.6 million average anticipated grant amount
- 5. CDBG and HOME grants comprise 23.3% of total grant funding

Goals & Objectives

- Provide expenditure authority for anticipated grants for specific operating purposes
- Support objectives and strategies of departments that receive grants


Key Issues

- 1. Obtaining new grant funding sources
- 2. Coordinating grant applications
- 3. Manage decreases in grant funding
- 4. Majority of grant funding through the Federal Government (68.7%)
- 5. Managing the American Rescue Plan Act grant

2023 ARPA Funding

- Unanticipated grant funding decreased by \$221 million to \$30 million
- Reflects removal of authority for ARPA funding
- First ARP payment of \$197.1 million received in May 2021
- Second ARP payment of \$197.1 million received in June 2022

Grants Expenditures vs CDBG & HOME Grant Awards (in millions)



2021 Expenditures

- 2021 Expenditures of \$115.3 million; significantly higher than trend
- Primary reason: various COVID related grants
- COVID grants comprise \$74.1 million of 2021 expenditures (64.3%)
 - Higher than average annual grant expenditures 2000-2019
- COVID grant expenditures include
 - \$27.1 million: Emergency Rental Assistance
 - \$11 million: Coronavirus Relief Fund (CARES Act)
 - \$8.7 million: Epidemiology & Laboratory Capacity
 - \$6.7 million: ARPA (Local Fiscal Recovery Fund)
 - \$6.4 million: Community Development Block Grant
