Non renewal, based upon second non appearance, of the Class "D" Bartender License of Nikki I. Colletta. (Committee vote: Ayes: 4 and Excused: 1).

Non renewal, based upon second non appearance, of the Class "D" Bartender License of Adriana Gonzalez. (Committee vote: Ayes: 4 and Excused: 1).

Non renewal, based upon the second non appearance of the Class "D" Bartender License of Shuezeng Her. (Committee vote: Ayes: 4, and Excused: 1).

Non renewal, based upon third non appearance of the Class "D" Bartender License of Judith E. Palms. (Committee vote: Ayes: 4 and Excused: 1).

Non renewal based upon the second non appearance, of the Class "D" Bartender License of William T. Roberson, III. (Committee vote: Ayes: 4 and Excused: 1).

Non renewal, based upon the second non appearance, of the Class "D" Bartender License of Melissa S. Van Pietersom. (Committee vote: Ayes: 4 and Excused: 1).

Report on the Renewal Application of the Class "D"

Bartender License of John F. Carter

FINDINGS OF FACT


 John F. Carter (hereinafter the "Licensee") is the holder of a Class "D" Bartender License in the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin. Said license expired at midnight, December 31, 2010.

2. An application to renew said license was untimely filed with the Office of the City Clerk on March 13, 2008.

3. Pursuant to Chapter 90 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances and Chapter 125 of the Wisconsin Statutes, the matter was referred to the Milwaukee Police Department for investigation. On October 30, 2010, the Milwaukee Police Department responded with a police report that could form a basis for non-renewal or suspension of said license.

4. On December 22, 2010 the City Clerk's Office provided timely notice to the Licensee pursuant to Chapter 90 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances and Chapter 125 of the Wisconsin Statutes of the report of the Milwaukee Police Department and included therewith a copy of the Milwaukee Police Department report. The matter was scheduled for a hearing on the Police Department report on January 5, 2011, commencing at 1:30 p.m. in Room 301B of City Hall. At said date, time and place, the licensee did not appear and he was not represented by counsel. That was the applicant's second nonappearance.

5. Based upon the sworn testimony heard and the evidence received at the hearing, the Committee finds the following:



A. A notice of the hearing as well as a copy of the police report was sent to John F. Carter at 108 East Meinecke Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53212 on December 22, 2010 by U.S. prepaid first-class mail in an envelope bearing the return address of the License Division. The address of 108 East Meinecke Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53212 is the address given by the Licensee on his application. The envelope was not returned to the License Division by the United States Postal Service. The Licensee failed to appear at the hearing on January 5, 2011.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- The Committee has jurisdiction to hold hearings and provide Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and a Recommendation to the full Common Council pursuant to Chapter 125 of the Wisconsin Statutes and Chapter 90 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances.
- Based on the above facts found, the Committee concludes that the
 Licensee, John F. Carter has not met the criteria of Chapter 125 of the
 Wisconsin Statutes or Chapter 90 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances to
 allow renewal of the Class "D" Bartender license based upon a second
 nonappearance.
- 3. In order to protect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Milwaukee, it is the recommendation of the Licenses Committee that the full Common Council should exercise its discretion to not renew the Class "D" Bartender license held by John F. Carter based upon a second nonappearance.

RECOMMENDATION

Based upon the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law stated above, the Committee, by a vote of four (4) ayes and one (1) excused, recommends that the Class "D" Bartender License be denied based upon a second nonappearance.
