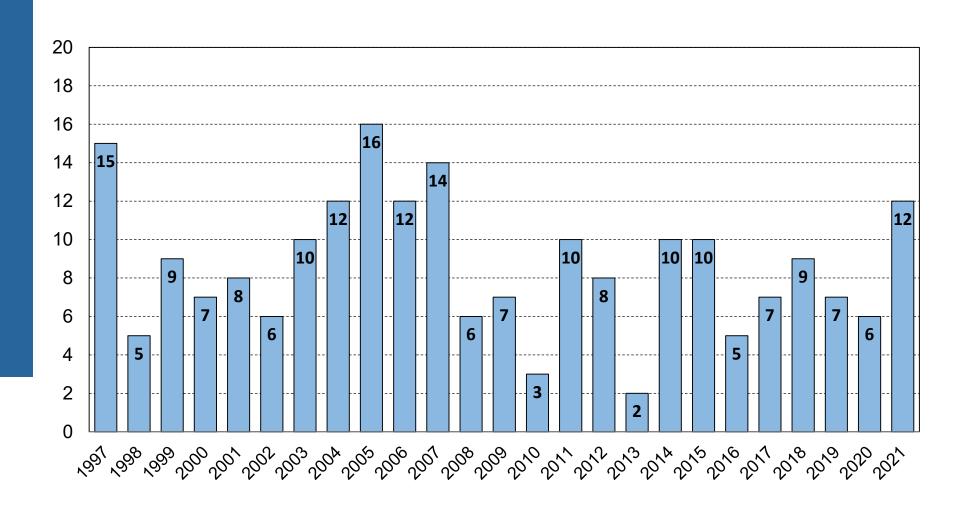

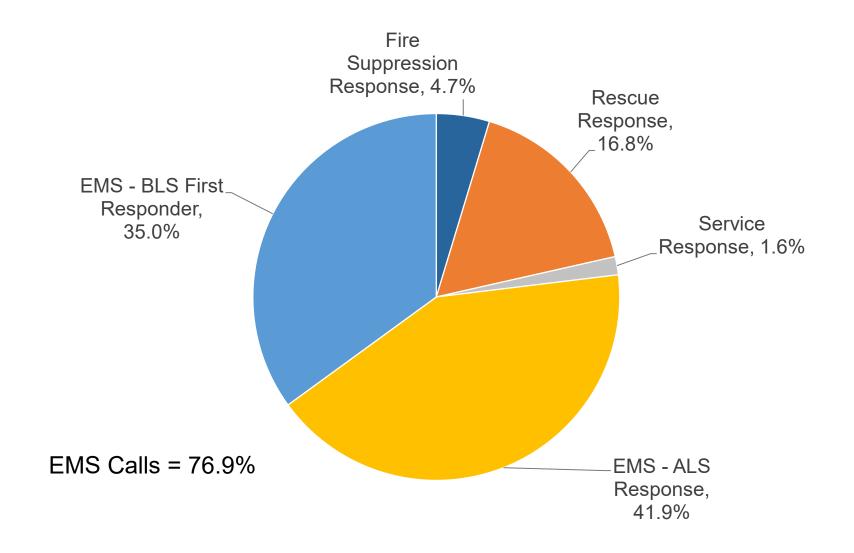

### Budget & Service Changes

- 1.5 engines decommissioned reduction of 22.5 FTE
  - One out of service on 1/1/2023
  - One out of service on 7/1/2023
- \$75 million of American Rescue Plan Act funds to fund operations
  - Approximately 470 FTE
- \$5 million of ARPA for BLS subsidy
