2. On 03/06/21 at 7:29pm Milwaukee Police Officers investigated a robbery complaint which occurred at 3115 W. Fond Du Lac Av. The victim stated that he was at the gas station located at 3115 W. Fond Du Lac Av and left his car parked at the gas pump running to enter the store. When he returned, his vehicle was gone, and then an unknown subject approached the victim. The subject stated that he knows who took his car and if he gives him money, he can get it back for him. The victim agreed and another subject returned with his vehicle. The first subject then grabbed the victim by his arm and stated that he is owed money. The victim gave him all the money he had which was approximately \$200 dollars. The victim gave officers the descriptions of the subjects and the officers filed reports regarding the incident.

- 3. On 03/28/21 at 3:10am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 3115 W. Fond Du Lac Av, for a Shot Spotter complaint. Officers located 20 casings in the parking lot of the location and observed two vehicles struck by gunfire. Officer spoke with the employee who stated that one of the suspects entered the store produced a handgun. The suspect asked for a pack of cigarettes and paid for the item, then went outside. The suspect then began firing at another suspect who was shooting back. The employee stated that security cameras covered the incident but the owner can only access the cameras and could make a copy after 8:00 am. During the course of the investigation, a shooting suspect/victim arrived at St. Joseph's Hospital.
- 4. On 03/31/21 at 8:44am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 3115 W. Fond Du Lac Av, for a robbery complaint. Officers spoke with the victim who stated an unknown suspect took money from his hand then ran from the location. The victim stated that he took the money from the store ATM, and cut his finger during the course of using the ATM. The victim was transported to the hospital for medical treatment. Officers spoke with the store clerk who was uncooperative, refused to give officers his information, and stated to contact the owner. Officers attempted to enter the enclosed area to review video and the clerk refused to allow officers in the area. Officers spoke with the owner, who stated that he would be at the store within an hour to review video. Officers further spoke with the victim who stated that the morning clerk told him to get out of the location while he was attempting to call for police service. The clerk came from behind the enclosed area with a bat and swung it at him as if he would hit him. The clerk then grabbed the victim's bike from within the store and threw it outside. Officers returned to the location and the owner was not at the location, and did not return phone calls. Officers filed reports regarding the robbery and had to conduct follow up regarding video later.
- 5. On 09/25/2021 at 3:25am officers were dispatched to a Shooting at 3115 W. Fond du lac Av. The investigation revealed the victim was in the parking lot at 3115 W. Fond du lac Av flirting with a female. The driver of an auto in the lot yelled something and began shooting at the victim. The victim noticed he was shot and drove himself home. The clerks stated they did not hear any shots fired. The officers located casings in the parking lot. The clerk stated their cameras were working but could not be accessed until 2pm.
- 6. On 10/12/2021 at 11:57am officers were dispatched to a Shooting at 3115 W. Fond du lac Av. The officers located a shooting victim in the parking lot. The officers interviewed the manager, who stated the victim was panhandling on the lot and was told to leave. An auto, which had just pulled away from a pump, pulled up to the victim and got into an argument. The driver of the auto exited the car and shot the victim twice. The store clerk stated he did not hear the shots and cannot see outside because the view is blocked by cigar boxes. The manager assisted officers in viewing video of the incident.
- 7. On 04/14/2022 at 11:35pm officers were dispatched to a Shooting at N. 32nd St. and W. Locust St. The officers located a homicide victim in the parking lot at 3115 W. Fond du lac Av. The officers interviewed the clerk, who was uncooperative. A different clerk arrived to attempt to recover video but was unsuccessful because the exterior cameras were not functioning.

- 8. On 06/01/2022 at 12:33am officers were dispatched to Shot Spotter at 3115 W. Fond du lac Av. The officer interviewed the clerk, who stated he was inside assisting customers and he only heard the shots. The cameras were operating but provided a live feed and the officers could not view video of the incident. The officers located 9 casings in the parking lot.
- 9. On 06/14/2022 at 12:33am officers were dispatched to a Shot Spotter call at 3140 W. Fond du lac Av. The officers located a shooting victim, who initially stated he was on the parking lot of the gas station at 3115 W. Fond du lac Av. The victim then became uncooperative with the officers. The officers interviewed the clerk at the gas station and he stated he heard a loud boom outside but could not tell how far away it was. The station has video cameras but the officers were not able to see video from the incident. The officers searched the parking lot for evidence but did not locate anything.
- 10.On 06/21/2022 a meeting was held at district 7 regarding the gas station at 3115 W. Fond du lac Av. being designated a nuisance property. The building owner was present with his lawyer. The business was asked to close at midnight and the lawyer stated they do not need to close to abate the nuisance activity. The owner stated they were attempting to hire security but were having difficulties locating a company. They also stated they were going to add exterior lighting.

On Saturday, 25, 2021, Squad 7332 (PO DAWSON/PO MOORE) was dispatched to the address of 3115 W. Fond Du Lac Ave, Citgo Gas Station, located in the City and County of Milwaukee, in the State of Wisconsin, for a "Shooting" Complaint. During the investigation 2 bronze 40 caliber casings were located

in the listed addresses parking lot. Squad 7340 (PO OURS) spoke to the employees of the business who stated to him that no shooting had occurred at their gas station. After the casings were found the employees then stated that their camera systems work but no one is able to operate it until 2pm.

SHOOTING DETAILS:

The victim statement was taken by Detective RUBIO, PEAVY stated to Detective RUBIO that he was driving home and stopped at the gas station, W Locust St and W Fond Du Lac Ave, on his way home. PEAVY stated he pulled into the gas station and parked at a pump facing W. Fond Du Lac Ave. PEAVY stated that he observed a 4 door silver sedan, unknown of the make & model, parked at the pump across from his vehicle. PEAVY stated he exited his vehicle and began to walk to the gas station. PEAVY stated he briefly flirted with an unknown black female that was walking out of the gas station. PEAVY stated as he was talking to the "female", the driver of the silver sedan exited the vehicle and yelled something at PEAVY, but could not make out what it was. PEAVY stated the driver then displays a handgun and fires an unknown amount of rounds towards him. PEAVY stated as the suspect was shooting at him, PEAVY took cover on the passenger side of his own vehicle. PEAVY stated when the shots stopped, he heard the silver sedan speed away from the gas station in an unknown direction. PEAVY stated he observed that he was shot and drove home, where his mother called 911. PEAVY stated that during the shooting he did not observe the black female in the parking lot. PEAVY stated he believes that the female entered the suspect's vehicle and fled the scene.

This report is written by P.O. Douglas PAVLIK, assigned to District 7, Early Power Shift.

On 10/12/2021 at approximately 11:57AM, I (Squad 7269) was dispatched to a Shooting Complaint at the address of 3115 W. Fond Du Lac Ave. which is in the City and County of Milwaukee. Upon arrival a shooting victim James M. COMBS (B/M 01/29/1992) was located with a witness Patrice D. JACKSON (B/F 06/30/1975) in the gas station parking lot. JACKSON and COMBS were panhandling in front of the store on the gas station property. The manager Bilal MUHAMMAD (W/M 10/18/1992) stated he arrived on the scene and told JACKSON and COMBS they had to leave the property. MUHAMMAD stated COMBS and JACKSON argued with him but they started to walk away from the store.

Shortly after COMBS and JACKSON were told to leave the property a tan Mitsubishi is seen leaving pump #5 from the gas station parking lot and backing up by COMBS and JACKSON. It appeared COMBS and JACKSON got into an argument with the occupants of the tan Mitsubishi. An occupant of the Mitsubishi got out of the vehicle and shot JACKSON in the twice The vehicle flees southbound on N. 32nd St. after the shooting.

One of the occupants of the Mitsubishi got out of the vehicle and went into the store.

A total of five casings were recovered from the parking lot of the gas station.

I spoke to the clerk Junaid REHMAN (W/M 10/31/1993) who was reluctant to give us his name and information. After talking with REHMAN a little more he finally gave me his information. REHMAN stated he only heard voices outside but didn't hear the gunshots. REHMAN stated he can't see outside due to cigar boxes blocking his view outside.

On Thursday, April 14th, 2022, at approximately 11:39 pm, my partner P.O. Daryal GOSS and I (Squad 7440) were dispatched to a Shooting complaint at the address of N 32nd St and W Locust St, which is located in the City and County of Milwaukee, WI. During the investigation we located a victim at the address of 3115 W Fond Du Lac Ave (GPC Quik Mart). It should be noted that this location is a licensed establishment in the City of Milwaukee, WI.

Upon arrival, we observed a 25 year old male with multiple gunshot wounds. There were also three casings in the parking lot. These findings were consistent with a shooting taking place on the parking lot of this licensed City of Milwaukee establishment.

An unidentified secondary employee arrived on scene and attempted to play back video footage from the exterior cameras. This attempt was unsuccessful due to the exterior cameras being out of service. Had the exterior cameras been operational, it would have been greatly helpful and would have caught the Homicide on camera.

I will attempt to contact the owner later on April 15th, 2022 to properly notify him of the license premise report being filed.

On Tuesday June 21st, 2022 I met with the owner of the building at 3115 W Fond Du Lac Av. That location is GPC Quick Mart and the building owner is Pearls One LLC. The registered agent for Pearls One, and the person I met with, was Daljit S KLER (W/M 3/17/1963). Also, present at the meeting was Daljit's son, Mandeep KLER, as well as their lawyer, Paul Oberer. Also, at the meeting was ACA Michael RADAVICH, Capt. Carolyn BIRCH, and Sgt. Matthew Mengel. This meeting was held to discuss an abatement plan for the nuisance designation of 3115 W Fond Du Lac Av. During the meeting ACA RADAVICH asked that the premises commit to assuring that there is adequate memory to keep their camera systems in working order and the police be given access to the footage if requested. Atty. Oberer stated that they would add that into the written abatement plan.

ACA RADAVICH requested that the premise voluntarily close their business at 12:00AM instead of being open for 24 hours. Atty. If you timely provide a written course of action, I shall evaluate it to determine if it is a reasonable attempt at abating the nuisance activity. You will receive a written response whether your proposed course of action is accepted or rejected.
