NATURE OF CALL/ JUSTIFICATION

On Wednesday, April 6, 2022 at approximately 11:33 pm, PO Travis CAPELLE and I (Squad 4460) were dispatched to a SHOTS FIRED complaint located at 4707 W Mill Rd. The listed address is to the Coconut Bowling alley. This address is located in both the City and County of Milwaukee, WI. Multiple callers of this complaint stated that approximately 30 gunshots could be heard in the immediate area.

INVESTIGATION

Upon arrival at 4707 W Mill Rd, PO CAPELLE and I pulled our fully marked MPD squad car into the parking lot of the bowling alley. We approached the main entrance of the business and spoke to the security officer who stated that he heard multiple gun shots coming from the Mill Rd area just north of the building but did not see who was shooting as he was inside of the building at that time. The security staff stated that no one was injured during this incident and the final two patrons were exiting the business. The security staff stated that the regular bowling league completed an event along with approximately 10 patrons who were celebrating a birthday party. The security staff stated that there were no issues inside of the business and the bowling league consist of mostly elderly members.

PO CAPELLE and I walked through the north parking lot of the business where we discovered approximately 7 brass casings near the entrance of the parking lot and sidewalk area. PO CAPELLE and I then proceeded to walk along the westbound travel lane of W Mill Rd between N 47th and N 49th St were we located an additional 30 brass casings along the roadway. Officers did not observe any property damage along W Mill Rd as a result of this incident.

FOLLOW UP

PO CAPELLE and I collected the brass casings and processed the scene by taking 49 photographs. The bowling alley is equipped with two separate security camera systems that covers the interior and exterior of the building. One of the security systems is an older out dated unit that covers the parking lot area in which the owner does not have the password. The newer security camera covers the internal areas of the building as well as the main entrance and exterior of the main entrance.

Due to the business being closed, the owner stated that officers can view security footage and receive a copy of the images on Friday, April 8, 2022 when he can meet officers at the location.

PO CAPELLE and I returned to District 4 where we placed the casings on inventory and completed the required reports.

The business owners of COCONUT BOWLING alley were called in to a meeting at District 4 on May 2, 2022 regarding a SHOTS FIRED complaint that occurred on Wednesday, April 6, 2022. On that day, responding officers located 37 casings in the parking lot and also the roadway of W Mill Rd.

Attending the meeting were Captain ORTIZ, District 4 CLO's, DNS, City Attorney, Milwaukee Safe and Sound and the business owners. The Shots Fired incident was the basis of the meeting and the owners were informed of the standpoint of MPD and what could happen going forward if similar incidents occur centered around their business. The bowling alley has complied with the changes that were suggested at the meeting and regular business checks have been conducted to ensure the changes have been met.

Since this incident, the owner of this establishment has hired additional security staff members to patrol the exterior of the building during hours of operation. The owner also installed an additional camera which covers more of the north parking lot and parking lot entrance.

The business owner also informed officers that he directed his mobile security guards to patrol the neighborhood during normal business hours and to report any suspicious behavior to the police.

Since the Shots Fired incident there have been no calls for service regarding the bowling alley. The owners are aware that members of the community do not want the business at that location and is currently trying to find a common ground where they can exist together without friction

Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally, witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
