The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 07/15/12 at 1:30 am, Milwaukee police officers that were on foot patrol, observed a fight in front of Buckheads Saloon in the street. Officers broke up the fight and had four subjects in custody and one officer observed the doorman of the bar bleeding from the eye. The doorman was identified as Darrell Dixon and investigation revealed that an altercation took place inside the bar with the parties involved being kicked out. The fight continued outside with Dixon attempting to break it up but was accidentally being punched by one of the actors. Citations were issued to the four patrons for disorderly conduct with a battery citation being issued to the patron who punched Dixon.

7. On 08/03/2014 Milwaukee police observed a fight at 1044 North Old World Third Street. One of the combatants had been escorted out of Buckhead Saloon by security. While leaving the bar, he became involved in another altercation. Milwaukee police incident report #142150004 filed.

- 9. On 02/20/2015 Milwaukee police conducted a tavern check at Buckheads Saloon (1044 North Old World Third Street). The officer provided a packet containing tavern related ordinances and discussed procedures to prevent them from being violated.
- 10 On 02/26/2015 a 19 year old Milwaukee police aide, working in conjunction with Milwaukee police, attempted to gain entry to Buck Heads Saloon (1044 North Old World Third Street) but was turned away when she could not produce proof she had attained the legal drinking age of 21.
- 11. On 05/10/2015 Milwaukee police were flagged down by the manager of Buckhead Saloon (1004 North Old World Third Street) who stated a patron had been hit with a glass and was bleeding badly. Investigation revealed a patron, Bryce Kratzer, of the business attempted to intervene in an incident involving a friend of his. Kratzer was hit in the face with an unknown object by an unknown suspect. Kratzer received over 100 stitches to his face as a result of this incident. Milwaukee police incident report #151300007 filed. During this investigation, it came to officer's attention that Kratzer possessed someone else's identification card and that Kratzer was under the legal drinking age of 21. Kratzer was cited for possession of alcohol beverages by underage person and misrepresentation of age.

- 12. On 07/12/2015 Milwaukee police responded to an accident at North Old World Third Street and East Juneau Avenue. One of the involved parties, Alezandra Duarte whose birthday is 12/20/1994, identified herself as an employee of Buckheads Saloon and stated she had hit a bus. Duarte told the officer she had been drinking while working at Buckheads and was subsequently arrested for operating while intoxicated. On 07/16/2016, the officer went to Buckheads Saloon (1044 North Old World Third Street) and spoke to manager Michael Albanese. Albanese confirmed that Duarte had worked the night of July 11<sup>th</sup> to July 12<sup>th</sup>. The officer asked Albanese what the bars policy is for letting underage employees drink alcohol while working and was told they usually allow underage employees to have one or two drinks while they work. On 07/18/2015, the officer received a phone call from the applicant who stated that underage employees are not allowed to drink while working and Duarte would be fired as a result of this incident.
- 13.On 08/07/2015 a 20 year old Milwaukee police aide, working in conjunction with Milwaukee police, attempted to gain entry to 1044 North Old World Third Street (Buckheads) but was challenged at the point of entry and turned away when she could not produce proof she had attained the legal drinking age of 21.
- 14. On 01/16/2016 Milwaukee police were flagged down at 1044 North Old World Third Street by a subject, Cody Crangle, who stated he had been pepper sprayed by security staff at the Red, White and Blue tavern. Investigation revealed Crangle had been a patron at the bar and refused to leave the premise at bar close. After becoming argumentative and refused to leave when instructed by security. Security began to physically remove Crangle and began to physically resist security at which time Crangle was sprayed with pepper spray. Crangle left the location and came back. When he returned he began to pund on the door and threaten to harm security. Security re-initiated contact with Crangle and pepper sprayed him a second time. Crangle received medical attention and was cited.
- 15.On 03/30/2017 officers conducted underage tavern enforcement in District 1. An underage Police Aid attempted to gain entry to Red, White & Blue at 1044 N. Old World Third St. The Police Aid was not allowed in the tavern by security at the door.
- 16. On 04/06/2017 officers were monitoring Red, White & Blue, 1044 N. Old World Third St, because they were having an all you can drink special. Officers encountered 2 subjects that were intoxicated that had used fake ID's to enter. They encountered another subject who was intoxicated and disorderly. A Police sergeant was on scene arresting an intoxicated subject who was resisting the Sergeant. This subject was found to be underage and used his brother's ID to enter the tavern.
- 17. On 08/23/2017 officers conducted fake identification training at 1044 N. Old World Third St. The representatives from the tavern were instructed in how to detect fake ID's.

18. On 11/10/2017 officers were flagged down at 1044 N. Old World Third St for a trouble with subject. The officer observed security holding a subject down on the ground. The subject was resisting officers attempts to put on handcuffs. They were able to get the subject detained and interview security who stated the subject was kicked out and returned striking one of the door men in the head with a closed fist. The subject was arrest for Disorderly Conduct.

- 19. On 01/01/2018 officers investigated a possible sexual assault/ theft complaint that occurred sometime that morning. The victim, who is 20 years old, stated she was working at Red White & Blue that night. She admitted to drinking while she worked but stated she did not drink that much and thought she may have been drugged because she did not remember how she got home. The officer watched video at several bars and found that after leaving work the victim was at other taverns in the area until about 8:50am. The sexual assault was determined to be baseless and the victim's phone was located at The Pub Club.
- 20. On 10/13/2018 at 11:30pm an officer was advised by a citizen that the citizen heard someone talking on a phone about underage people coming in the back door of Club Red White and Blue. The officer saw a group of people waiting outside the back door and went inside and approached that door from the inside. The officer observed an employee of Red White and Blue open the back door and allow the patrons inside. The officer asked for the ID's of the subjects and was advised they had no ID's and were underage. The officer escorted the subjects out and spoke with the manager who stated he was aware of what happened and stated he would more control of the rear door.
- 21. On 10/20/2018 at 12:03am an officer heard loud music coming from the outside speakers at Club Red White and Blue, 1044 N. Old World Third St. The officer stated the music prevented normal conversation and had previously warned the management at the business to turn have it turned down at 12:00am. The officer approached the staff at the door to turn the music down, which did occur at 12:10am.
- 22. On 11/29/2018 officers conducted underage tavern enforcement in District 1 at Red White and Blue. The tavern passed the check.
- 23.On 07/20/2019 at 12:35am a subject waiting in line at Red White and Blue, 1044 N. Old World Third St, struck a security guard to the face, breaking his nose. The applicant and all employees were cooperative with the investigation.
- 24. On 07/24/2019 at 1:26am officers were flagged down by security at Red White and Blue for a disorderly patron. The subject was refusing to leave the patio area at closing time. Security was escorting him out and the subject hit one of the security guards to the face. The subject was issued a citation for Assault and Battery and released. The security was cooperative with the officers and provided surveillance video to the officers.
- 25. On 08/31/2019 at 1:54am officers responded to Red White and Blue, 1044 N. Old World Third St for a Trouble with Subject. The manager stated a subject refused to leave the bar at closing time. As security was escorting the subject out he physical resisted and grabbed on the doors so he could not be removed. He resisted the officers knocking them to the ground. The subject was issued citations. At 2:22am a different subject was disorderly outside and was told to leave the area. The subject returned and was arrested.
- 26. On 01/03/2020 at 1:41am officers responded to Red White and Blue, 1044 N. Old World Third St for a Trouble with Subject complaint. The staff stated there were 2 subjects refusing to leave. The officers asked the subjects to leave the tavern and they refused. The subjects were removed and issued citations.

- 27. On 01/10/2020 at 11:11pm officers were flagged down for a Trouble with Subject at Red with and Blue, 1044 N. Old World Third St. The staff stated a subject attempted to enter the business by jumping the back fence. The same subject attempted to enter the front door but was refused entry because of over intoxication. The subject was issued a citation.
- 28. On 02/18/2020 officers investigated a Sexual Assault that occurred on 02/16/2020 at 9:30pm at Red White and Blue, 1044 N. Old World Third St. The business was holding an event that night. The victim was intoxicated and the subject assaulted her in the middle of the first floor bar. The assault was captured on video and was posted on social media. The officers spoke with the manager and instructed him to remove the pictures from their Facebook page. The manager was cooperative with the investigation.
- 29. On 02/22/2020 at 1:50am an officer was flagged down for a Theft at Red White and Blue, 1044 N. Old World Third St. The victim stated he phone was in a side pocket in her purse. She was by the door with a lot of foot traffic when she noticed her phone missing from the pocket. The staff was cooperative with the officer's investigation.
- 30. On 03/13/2020 at 12:06am officers were flagged down by security at Red White and Blue, 1044 N. Old World Third St, for a Trouble with Subject. The subject was refusing to pay his bill and was being loud and boisterous with security. The bar had run the subjects credit card but he was refusing to sign the receipt. The subject did sign and left the premise. The same day at 1:54am the officer was flagged down again for a Trouble with Subject. Security was pointing to a group that was walking away stating they were refusing to leave. The subject left when the police arrived on scene.
- 31. On 03/13/2020 at 1:31am officers observed a disturbance at Red White and Blue, 1044 N. Old World Third St. Security was denying a subject entry because he had been asked to leave earlier in the night and refused to pay his bill. The subject refused to leave and grabbed the security officer in a "bear hug". Security was able to get the subject outside, which is when the officers arrived on scene. The subject was arrested and cited for Disorderly Conduct.
- 32. On 03/15/2020 at 12:52am officers were flagged down by security at Red White and Blue, 1044 N. Old World Third St, for a Trouble with Subject. The officer observed security holding a subject down on the ground. The subject was being loud and boisterous manner toward staff and patrons. The officers arrested the subject and cited him for Disorderly Conduct.
- 33. On 10/16/2020 at 1:59am officers were dispatched to Red White & Blue, 1044 N. Martin Luther King Jr Dr. for a Property Damage. The officers spoke with the manager who stated a subject was at the all you can drink event and did not purchase a wristband. Security escorted the subject out and he returned with a brick and broke the window. The manager provided video of the incident.
- 34 On 02/13/2021 at 1:51am officers were dispatched to a Sick/Injured at Red White & Blue, 1044 N. Martin Luther King Jr Dr. Upon arrival the staff at the bar assisted the officers in locating the female, who was sitting at a table unconscious. The female was conveyed to the hospital for treatment. She was found to be in possession of her older sisters ID card. The female was cited for misrepresentation of age.

- 35.On 04/02/2021 officers were flagged down for a Trouble with Subject at Red White & Blue, 1044 N. Martin Luther King Jr Dr. The officers spoke with security, who were detaining a subject for theft of liquor bottles.
- 36. On 04/11/2021 at 12:37am officers observed a disturbance in the line at Red White & Blue, 1044 N. Martin Luther King Jr Dr. The officers spoke with the manager, who stated a subject was kicked out of the bar for over intoxication. The subject was attempting to get back in, causing a disturbance. The subject was arrested and issued a citation.
- 37.On 05/16/2021 at 2:00am officers were dispatched to a Sexual Assault at Red White & Blue, 1044 N. Martin Luther King Jr Dr. The officers spoke with a bathroom attendant, who observed a male and female having sex in the bathroom. The male was kicked out and police were called. The female was intoxicated and did not remember the incident.
- 38.On 06/05/2021 at 12:48am officers observed a fight at 215 W. Highland Av. Both parties stated the fight started inside Red White & Blue, 1044 N. Martin Luther King Jr Dr. They were kicked out by security and continued to fight outside.
- 39. On 06/19/2021 at 1:23am officers were flagged down by the manager at Red White & Blue, 1044 N. Martin Luther King Jr Dr. for a Trouble with Subject. The manger stated a subject grabbed a bottle from behind the bar and was pouring drinks. The subject was kicked out by security.
- 40. On 06/19/2021 at 1:54am officers were flagged down by a subject who stated he was battered on the dance floor by another patron inside Red White & Blue, 1044 N. Martin Luther King Jr Dr. The manger was cooperative and provided officers with video of the incident.
- 41.On 09/26/2021 at 12:07am officers responded to a fight at Red White & Blue, 1044 N. Martin Luther King Jr Dr. The officers observed security attempting to prevent two females from entering. Security pointed out a subject who was fighting in the bar. The subject fought with officers when they attempted to take him into custody.
- 42. On 02/25/2022 at 1:04am officers were dispatched to a Sick and Injured at 1044 N. Martin Luther King Jr Dr. The officers spoke with security, who stated a subject was highly intoxicated and vomiting inside the bar. The officers called for medical treatment for an incapacitated subject.
- 43. On 02/27/2022 at 1:35am officers were dispatched to a Fight at Red White & Blue, 1044 N. Martin Luther King Jr Dr. The officers spoke with security, who stated they escorted a disorderly subject out. The subject ran back into the business. As they were escorting him out a second time he became upset and kicked out the glass front door. The subject was issued a citation.
- 44. On 07/14/2022 at 11:52pm officers conducted a license premise check at Red White & Blue, 1044 N. Martin Luther King Jr Dr. The officer observed security officers at the door and throughout the establishment. He discussed with the manager about using a metal detector at the door. The manager stated he was new and would discuss it with the owner.
- 45. On 08/05/2022 at 1:03am officers were flagged down by security at Red White & Blue, 1044 N. Martin Luther King Jr Dr. regarding a disorderly subject. Security stated a subject was

intoxicated and refused to leave. The subject became aggressive with officers and was cited for Disorderly Conduct. Thursday nights are all you can drink night and is known for heavily intoxicated subjects leaving the establishment.

46. On 08/25/2022 at 1:41am officers were flagged down by security at Red White and Blue, 1044 N. Martin Luther King Jr Dr. for a fight. The officers observed two groups exit the tavern and argue in the street. The argument continued in the parking lot where they began fighting. One of the subjects was on the ground being hit when the officer observed him with a firearm. The subject dropped the gun when instructed. The subjects fighting then dispersed. The security manager stated he did not see the fight inside but he was told about it by his security officers. Security from the bar was outside attempting to separate the groups and were cooperative with officer. Security advised they check everyone for weapons prior to coming in the bar.

This report is written by PO Kevin ZAVADIL assigned to District 1 Late Power Shift.

On 9/26/2021 at approximately 12:07 AM, a fight was broadcasted over handheld radio at 1044 N Old World third (Red White & Blue) a staff member at RWB called and notified Police. I was at E State St and N Water St. Upon my arrival at 1044 N Old World third St. I observed two females yelling at security. RWB security was attempting to push the females away from the door to prevent them from entering the establishment. Security then pointed at a black male who was later identified as Deandre L. HOPSON (B/M 09/25/91). I observed HOPSON in no shirt, athletic pants, and bleeding from the lips. HOPSON initially approached Police with his lips bleeding. I asked HOPSON multiple times to step back. I was not sure if HOPSON was a victim or a suspect at that time and HOPSON appeared to be heavily intoxicated. Security pointed HOPSON out as an actor who was fighting in the establishment. It was shortly after it I was able to determined HOPSON was going to be taken into custody and placed into the MPD wagon. HOPSON became non-compliant and he used passive resistance by sitting down and using dead weight tactics. It was at this time SGT GRANDSARD and I attempted to pick up HOPSON and put him in the wagon. While attempting to escort HOPSON into the wagon HOPSON kicked SGT GRANDSARD in the right hand. Officers placed HOPSON on the ground and placed leg restraints on HOPSON to prevent further assault. HOPSON continued to resist and flail his body. I then applied a pressure point to HOPSON's right jaw area to gain control of HOPSON. It was then that officers attempted to place HOPSON in the MPD wagon, HOPSON began spit bodily fluids in the direction of officers. HOPSON intentionally and without consent bit my right upper forearm area causing pain and bruising. I yelled multiple commands for HOPSON to stop biting, and stop spitting at Officers. A spit mask was placed on HOPSON to prevent further assault. HOPSON was conveyed to the Police Administration Building.

On Friday, August 5th, 2022 (previous night being Thursday, 08-04-22) at 1:03 A.M., I was notified by a bouncer at the Red White and Blue Bar (RWB) located at 1044 North Dr. Martin L King Jr Dr (Formerly 1044 North Old World Third Street) that a customer was asked to leave and becoming aggressive with staff. The customer, Warren S. CRAWFORD (B/m 08-02-91) was heavily intoxicated and was somewhat incoherent. CRAWFORD was observed by the bouncer, James RUSHING (b/m 11-24-90) groping and aggressively dancing with female customers on the stage. According to the female patrons, they were uncomfortable with CRAWFORD's actions, so he was asked to leave.

CRAWFORD became aggressive with police officers in the vestibule, and was clearly heavily intoxicated. CRAWFORD was slurring his words and smelled of alcoholic beverages, and was stumbling when he walked. CRAWFORD was cited for disorderly conduct (Citation#J981DPGFC5) and taken into custody, and then conveyed to District 1 where he was released and called a rideshare to get home safely.

Thursday nights at RWB are known as \$10 all you can drink nights with a college identification card, or \$15 all you can drink if you do not have a college identification card. CRAWFORD'S level of intoxication is common for patrons exiting RWB on Thursday nights, which has caused numerous calls for medical service for heavily intoxicated subjects, as well as numerous fights and arrests for ordinance violations by heavily intoxicated citizens leaving the establishment.

The manager, James M. HERNANDEZ (w/m 07-10-86) was informed that a tavern report regarding this incident would be filed. HERNANDEZ was cooperative.

Both RWB's Class B Tavern License and Public Entertainment Premise license are valid through 11-06-2022.

This report was written by P.O. Shawn SWITZER, assigned to District One, Late Power Shift, Squad 1430.

On Friday, August 26, 2022 at approximately 1:41 am P.O Andrew DUDLEY and I were monitoring Red White and BLUE (RWB), which is a bar that is located at 1044 N Old World Third St. While monitoring the patrons exiting the establishment we were made aware of an argument that was occurring inside of the business.

Approximately 10 subjects exited the bar and began to shout on the sidewalk directly outside of the business. The security of RWB made many attempts to calm the situation, however, the subjects walked into the street and began to shout at each other.

The primary aggressor of this incident was an unknown black male, with short black hair, approximately 5'08" to 5'10" tall, wearing a white sleeveless tank top shirt. This subject continuously followed, yelled at, and ran towards approximately 3 other subjects.

One subject, who was arrested, was identified as Jacob M WALLS (b/m, 12-15-00). I observed WALLS, his brother Jonathan N LONG (b/m, 09-11-99), and their friend Decorion T JENNINGS (b/m, 07-27-00) attempting to walk away from the other subjects, who followed them south bound on the 1000 block of N Old World Third St. WALLS, LONG, and JENNINGS turned and walked down an alley, which is located between 1031 N Old World Third St and 1029 N Old World Third St. This alley leads to a surface parking lot where WALLS had been parked at the time. I observed WALLS place both hands in front of his chest and apologize to the other subjects, he said I'm sorry, we are leaving now and that they didn't want to fight.

The subject in the white sort sleeved tank top approached WALLS, LONG, and JENNINGS, while WALLS was apologizing, and began to attack them along with approximately 7 other subjects. I attempted to stop the fight, and when I would stop one fight, other subjects would begin to fight approximately 10 feet from where I was.

When the fight was broken up, I observed WALLS standing on the north side of the parking lot. An unknown black male approached him from behind and used his right leg to trip him, which caused him to fall onto the ground. This subject, along with the subject in the white sleeveless shirt, began to strike him once again.

Approximately 2 minutes later, I heard P.O. Jeremy KENNER say drop the weapon. I drew my service

pistol and observed WALLS drop a black semi-automatic handgun from behind him. WALLS was approximately 50 feet away from the subjects who had been attacking him, I did not observe him point or retrieve the firearm.

I spoke with JENNINGS, who stated he did not know where the firearm came from. He stated he observed WALLS being hit, but was unable to provide any further information.

I spoke with LONG, who stated they were inside of RWB and he had been dancing with a female. He stated while dancing with her, another female caused an argument between him and the female. He stated while they were arguing he got upset and kicked a trash can, which hit the subject who was wearing the white tank top. LONG stated the subject became upset by that and hit him while they were in the bar. He stated they left the bar and were being followed to the parking lot. LONG stated while in the parking lot, he was being attacked by numerous subjects. He stated he told the subject to please get away but they wouldn't. LONG stated he observed WALLS being attacked while he was laying on the ground and attempted to help him. LONG stated he did not observe WALLS grab the firearm at any point and that he does not know LONG to carry a firearm.

I spoke with the Security Manager James W NEWMAN (w/m 01-21-88) who stated he did not observe the fight inside of the bar, however he was informed by other Security personnel that a large group of subjects began to fight inside of the bar.

I observed NEWMAN outside of the bar while the subjects were arguing, he was attempting to split up the two groups and calm the situation.

RWB does check every patron for weapons prior to allowing the to enter the building, they have a strict dress code, and I have observed them checking every patrons I.D.

RWB personnel was cooperative with this investigation and supplied any and all information that was requested.
