Dear Mr. Sir or Madam:

Enclosed please find a proposed resolution. We ask that it be referred to the Committee on Judiciary and Legislation with the following recommendation.

On May 9, 2022, the Sewer Maintenance Division responded to a complaint from claimant regarding sewer backup at 4402 North 65<sup>th</sup> Street. The field investigator dispatched to the location discovered that the City's eight-inch sanitary sewer was clogged. The investigator immediately enlisted a Jet-Vac cleaning crew to clear the sewer, relieving the backwater at the location.

On May 10, 2022, the sewer was examined and found to be in good condition and functioning properly. The clog was due to paper product build up in the sewer. The sewer is on a three year cleaning cycle and was last cleaned on November 3, 2021.

It is our position that the sewer backup did not result from the negligence of the City. In addition, when notified of the problem, Sewers responded in a timely manner and cleaned the sewer, alleviating the backwater at the location. Therefore, the City is not liable for damages in this case, and we recommend that the claim submitted by Karolin C. Winston in the amount of \$25,000.00 be denied.
