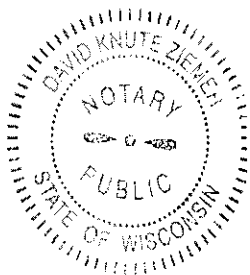

Substitute resolution approving levy-
ing of assessments and construction of
assessable public improvement projects
at various locations and appropriating
funds for these purposes with the City
cost of these projects approved by this
resolution is estimated to be \$489,
752.40 for a total estimated cost of
\$8,138,200.

Whereas, The Common Council of
the City of Milwaukee adapted prelimi-
nary resolutions, determining it neces-
sary and in the public interest to con-
struct and levy special assessments for
the following improvements:

11th Aldermanic District
W. Eden Pl. - S. 77th St. to S.
79th St. (ST21100105) File Num-
ber 100142: Asphalt pavement resur-
facing, replace curb and gutter, side-
walk and driveway approaches where
necessary, sodding (8.0-foot width of
tree border area), and grading.
(Assessable Reconstruction Paving Fund
- \$12,300; Nonassessable Reconstruc-
tion Paving Fund - \$60,000. The total
estimated cost for this project including
the requested amount is \$97,100. This
project is anticipated to be completed
during the 2011 construction season.

S. 77th St. - W. Warrinont
Ave. to W. Eden Pl. (ST21100103)
File Number 090105: Asphalt pave-
ment resurfacing, replace curb and gut-
ter, sidewalk and driveway approaches
where necessary, sodding (8.0-foot
width of tree border area), and grad-
ing. (Assessable Reconstruction Paving
Fund - \$3,100; Nonassessable Recon-
struction Paving Fund - \$60,000. The
total estimated cost for this project in-
cluding the requested amount is
\$87,100. This project is anticipated to
be completed during the 2011 construc-
tion season.

Resolved, By the Common Council of
the City of Milwaukee, that the Com-
missioner of Public Works' Report, as
amended at said Public Hearing, is ap-
proved and the properties therein iden-
tified are benefited; and, be it

Further Resolved, That said Commis-
sioner of Public Works is authorized
and directed to proceed with said work
in accordance with said report pursuant
to Section 66.0703 and any other per-
tinent sections of the Wisconsin Stat-
utes and in the manner directed by Sec-
tion 115-42 of the Milwaukee Code of
Ordinances; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the proper
departments take such action as is re-
quired of them to assess the abutting or
adjacent properties and collect such as-
sessment in the manner directed by Sec-
tion 115-42 of the Milwaukee Code of
Ordinances; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the City
Comptroller is authorized and directed
to transfer such funds which are availa-
ble for this purpose to the appropriate
capital Project/Grant accounts; and, be
it

Further Resolved, That the projects
do not involve any parcels of agricul-
tural land which are eligible for de-
ferred special assessments under the
provisions of Section 14.30 of the Mil-
waukee City Charter; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the City Engi-
neer and the Commissioner of Public
Works are hereby authorized to nego-
tiate and enter into an agreement with
the State of Wisconsin, Department of
Transportation for the City to under-
take construction management duties on
the following project: E. College Ave.
(ST32092401); and, be it

Further Resolved, That the City Engi-
neer is authorized and directed to ap-
prove and make periodic payments to
the State of Wisconsin, Department of
Transportation after receipt of invoices
from said State for the City's share of
the costs for said project: E. College
Ave. (ST32092401); and, be it

Further Resolved, That upon the com-
pletion of project E. College Ave.
(ST32092401) and a determination of
the actual cost(s), it is understood that if
the City of Milwaukee's share is less
than the amount previously paid, the
difference will be refunded to said City.

Further Resolved, That the Depart-
ment of Public Works is authorized to
use the funding as specified in the
above description of work; and, be it

Further Resolved, That projects: W.
Eden Pl. (ST21100105), S. 77th St.
(ST21100103), and E. College Ave.
(ST32092401) are to be allocated in the
2011 budget; and, be it

Further Resolved, That if surplus
funds become available, same or all of
the 2011 budget projects may be funded
with 2010 funds; and, be it

Further Resolved, That projects W.
Eden Pl. (ST21100105), S. 77th St.
(ST21100103), and E. College Ave.
(ST32092401) will be billed after Janu-
ary 1, 2013, but not before 12 months
after the project contract has been
completed.
