Office of the City Clerk Notice is hereby given that an ordinance that was introduced at the September 20, 2022 meeting of the Milwaukee Common Council, the essence of which is as follows:

A substitute ordinance relating to the 4th Amendment to the Detailed Planned Development known as Southgate Marketplace to allow for changes to an existing multi-tenant commercial building located at 3333 South 27th Street, on the west side of South 27th Street, north of West Morgan Avenue, in the 11th Aldermanic District.

The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Milwaukee ("Common Council"), do ordain as follows:

- Part 1. There is added to the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances ("MCO") a new section to read as follows:
- (1) In accordance with the provisions of Section 295-907 of the MCO relating to the establishment of planned development districts, the Common Council approves subject amended Detailed Planned Development, which is restricted to the time limit of 5 years from the effective date of this ordinance unless criteria per the s.295-907-2-c-11 met are referenced in Exhibit A, a copy of which is attached to this Common Council File which is on file in the office of the City Clerk and made a part as though fully set forth herein.
- (2) The zoning map is amended to change the zoning for the property located at: 3333 South 27th Street, Tax Key No. 533-1104-000 (subject of the file); other addresses included in the DPD boundary: 3415 South Street, Kev 27th Tax 533-1112-000; 3355 South Street, Tax Key No. 533-1111-000; 3233 South 27th Street, Tax Key No. 533-1101-000: and 3300 South 30th Street, Tax Key No. 533-1102-000 4th Amendment to Detailed Planned Development.
- (3) The requirements set forth in said detailed plan attached to this Common Council File as Exhibit A, constitute the zoning regulations for the area contained in such planned development district described, provided further, that the effect of the approval of such detailed plan is that

such plan shall limit and control construction, location, use and operation of all land and structures included within the detailed plan to all conditions and limitations set forth in such detailed plan.

Part 2. Any persons, firm, company or corporation owning. controlling or managing any building or premises wherein or whereon there shall be placed or there exists anything in violation of the terms of this ordinance; or who shall build contrary to the plans specifications submitted to and approved by the Commissioner of the Department of City Development, or any person, firm, company or corporation who shall omit, neglect or refuse to do any act required in this ordinance shall be subject to the penalties provided in Section 200-19 of the MCO.

Part 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions. The Common Council declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each section. subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases or other portions be declared void or invalid.

Notice is hereby further given that the foregoing matter will be given a public hearing by the Committee on Zoning, Neighborhoods and Development in Room 301-B, City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin, on Tuesday, October 25, 2022, at 9:00 A.M., pursuant to the provision of Sub-Section (7)(d) of Section 62.23 of the Revised Statutes of the State of Wisconsin.
