ARPA TIMELINE: A REFRESHER

- Fall 2021 Council Approves MHD Lead ARPA Project
- February 2022:
 - Final Rule from the Feds
 - HEH Director Onboarded
 - MHD Finance Director Onboarded
- March 2022:
 - Final Subaward template from CAO
 - SDC and Revitalize Milwaukee built out ARPA subaward program description and evaluation plan together
 - MHD ARPA budget approved
 - SDC ARPA budget created



ARPA TIMELINE: A REFRESHER

- May 2022:
 - SDC Subaward signed
 - HEH Manager (Quality Improvement and ARAP) Onboarded
- June July 2022
 - Processes, policies, and standard operating procedures (SOPs) built out
 - Quickbase built out for subawards
 - SDC ARPA staff hired
- August
 - 1st referrals to SDC began





ARPA TIMELINE: A REFRESHER

- 6 Months -
 - Length of time from final rule (February) to 1st referral (August).
- 3 4 Months -
 - Length of time from SDC subaward signature (May) to 1st referral (August)

 - \$7,824,300 Social Development Commission
 - \$9,976,640 Revitalize Milwaukee
 - \$3,206,750 Habitat for Humanity
 - \$21,007,690 Minimum TOTAL Encumbered

- 15 Micrograms per Deciliter and Above
 - Lead hazard reduction on property
 - Nurse case management
- 10 14.99 Micrograms per Deciliter (Pilot)
 - Lead hazard reduction on property
 - Nurse Intervention, which includes:
 - Nurse Home visit
 - Education and lead safe home kit
 - Developmental screening
 - Disclaimer: Intervention is contingent upon nurse staffing and case loads
- 3.5 9.99 Micrograms per Deciliter
 - Phone call by MHD or Sixteenth Street Community Health Centers
