This CPTED Survey is written by Police Officer Michael WARD. On 8-1-2022 PO Fabian GARCIA and I conducted this survey of 2950 S. Chase Ave, which is in the City and County of Milwaukee.

Listed Agent, Meghann EIDEN was not on scene due to a COVID exposure. Danny WOLSKE, Lost Prevention Manger, and Antonija NEKICH, Executive Team Leader of Remodeling, were on site for the meeting.

The location is an existing Box Store, General Merchandise Target. WOLSKE and NEKICH showed us the aisle (G24) and cooler space where the alcohol will be placed for sell. The aisle is located on the south east corner of the store. There will be a security camera that captures the area of where the product will be placed on shelf.

After 9:00pm the register will not be able to scan alcohol. The aisle where the alcohol will be shelved will not be blocked off after 9pm.

The area were product will be stored before being placed on the shelf will be monitored with a security camera.

The location has adequate lighting and security cameras, exterior and interior. Security cameras will monitored from the security room and can only be accessed by the Lost Prevention Team.

This concludes my report.




## City Concentration Map - 2950 S CHASE AV

The above application has been made by the above named applicant(s). This requires approval from the Licenses Committee and the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee. The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 11/9/2022 at 9:15 AM in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony via phone or internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

## Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
