There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

Hi Jim,

After receiving your initial email, I reached out to the Health Dept. for a detailed explanation of what the violations were and received the response below. I sent it over to JoCasta and she responded saying she did not what to issue a provisional license. Can you let us know what the options are? Can we require them to come before Committee and explain the lines, the violations, the lack of management that lead to the expiration of their license and occupancy? Does the City have the authority to not schedule their License hearing until the Health Dept. signs off first? Thanks for your help!

Hi Patty,

The Popeye's that is in Alderwoman Zamarippa's district is closed at this time. Here is a timeline recently of what we have been dealing with:

We received a complaint on October 3rd stating that there were leaks in the roof and that there was a fruit fly infestation.

We went out on October 3rd to verify the complaint. We were able to verify and in turn closed the restaurant due to significant leaks in the roof with water leaking onto food prep surfaces and a fruit fly infestation.

We went back on October 4^{th.} They asked us to come back and re-open them. We were not able to re-open since the violations were not corrected.

We re-opened them on October 6th. They had a pest company come out and there was a significant improvement in the amount of flies. We were told that the roof was fixed by an internal service person. They were not able to provide an invoice. We were not able to verify because it was not raining at that time.

We went back on October 13th to check for compliance (part of our procedure). They were closed again due to a significant fruit fly issues again.

They called us back out on October 14th to ask us to re-open them. They called us at the end of the day with no Inspectors available to go out. They were adamant that everything was fixed and they wanted to re-open. I told them that we typically do not work on the weekends, but that we had an Inspector that would be working Saturday morning and could stop out.

October 15th, our Inspector went out and was not able to re-open them. The fruit fly infestation was not any better.

We again went back again on October 16^{th} after being told that they problem was eradicated. It was not and they remained closed. N

They called again today and asked us to come back. We were supposed to go out at 2pm. They called us before and said that they were not ready.

Beyond all this, we have had significant compliance issues across the board at the Milwaukee Popeye's locations that are all owned by the same restaurant group.

I hope that this is helpfull Please let me know if you need anything else,

I realized after we spoke that the application that was recently granted for this location was a transfer. The transfer maintains the expiration date of the underlying license, which was October 4th. At this point, the licenses are expired.

We received the attached renewal application and payment however it is in the wrong entity's name. Could you have it amended and return it to me? At the same time, please file a provisional application as the extended hours need to be granted.

There is one last wrinkle, the BOZA approval for this store expired. A name change was approved recently but the underlying BOZA approval was never renewed. At this point, the Occupancy Permit is also expired. In order to issue the provisional the store needs a CO

Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
- Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
