Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, lilegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

#### LICENSE PREMISE REPORT

This report is written by P.O. Nicolas FERRANTE, assigned to District 5, Early Power Shift, Squad 5266 (with P.O. GARCIA), Community Partnership Unit.

On Sunday April 10, 2022 at approximately 4:00 PM I was advised by P.O. Eric BRANDT who was the District 5 Desk Police Officer that he had received multiple complaints regarding a block party in the area of N Holton St, and E Center St, in which multiple vehicles blocked off the roadway and set up bounce houses as well as playing loud music which could be heard down the block. I did a social media check in which I found a "Sedan SMITH (B/M 5-13-92) was hosting a non permitted block party from "1P - 7P at Holton and Center" sponsored by "Villegang" and "Breaking Barriers."

#### Investigation

Squad 5266 (P.O. GARACIA and I) as well as Squad 5260 (P.O. Matthew ROSEN and Shelisa CARSON) responded to the area and informed Squad 5217 (SGT Timothy PTASZEK) who informed us to monitor the event.

While monitoring the event Squad 5260 called to inform us (Squad 5266) that an anonymous citizen approached them and informed them that the liquor store located at 513 E Center St was assisting in hosting the block party. While the event was going on Squad 5266 and Squad 5260 observed multiple subjects entering and exiting the liquor store as well as brandishing open intoxicants. Due to the nature of the event an officer to subject ratio this was monitored and recorded on squad cameras.

#### Follow-Up

On Saturday April 16, 2022 Squad 5266 (P.O. Keith GARLAND and I) conducted follow-up at 513 E Center St regarding the event. We spoke to a Sunny SINGH (W/M 8-28-90) regarding the liquor stores involvement in the block part that occurred on Sunday April 10, 2022. SINGH stated "that they did not sponsor the event" and that the "activists took over the block" and they were "scared." SINGH stated numerous times they were not sponsoring the event and were scared. I informed SINGH next time to at least call to place a documented call regarding the event.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 11/9/2022 at 11:10 AM in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony via phone or internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

# Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
